Officers that responded to that alarm discovered that the contractors were there working because all of the tenants were moving out.</p> <p>The name of the company (contractors) was identified. No further information at this time.</p>

(3:23am) Officers arrived at business and discovered good B&E. The owner arrived and checked the security video. The video shows the suspect wearing a black jacket, gray hoody, blue jeans, and white gym shoes with black laces, a black paint ball mask, and black gloves. The suspect approached the business from the west side on foot. The suspect walks in front of the business 5 to 6 times looking at cars driving by on Telegraph Rd. The suspect then breaks out the west side front door window with a tire iron and enters the business. The suspect was then observed kicking in the manager's door and forces open several drawers. Suspect then leave's the business on foot carrying a bag. The suspect is last seen walking west from the business. Cash is missing from the manager's office.</p>

On 02-25-2015 an appraiser came to the home and found the front door wide open with the door knob on the ground. R/p from Real Estate Company checked the house and nothing appeared missing. He did observe a newer White Cadillac Deville circle the neighborhood three times slowly as he waited for officers to arrive. Officers checked the house and didn't find any damage to the pipes/furnace/structure of the home.
