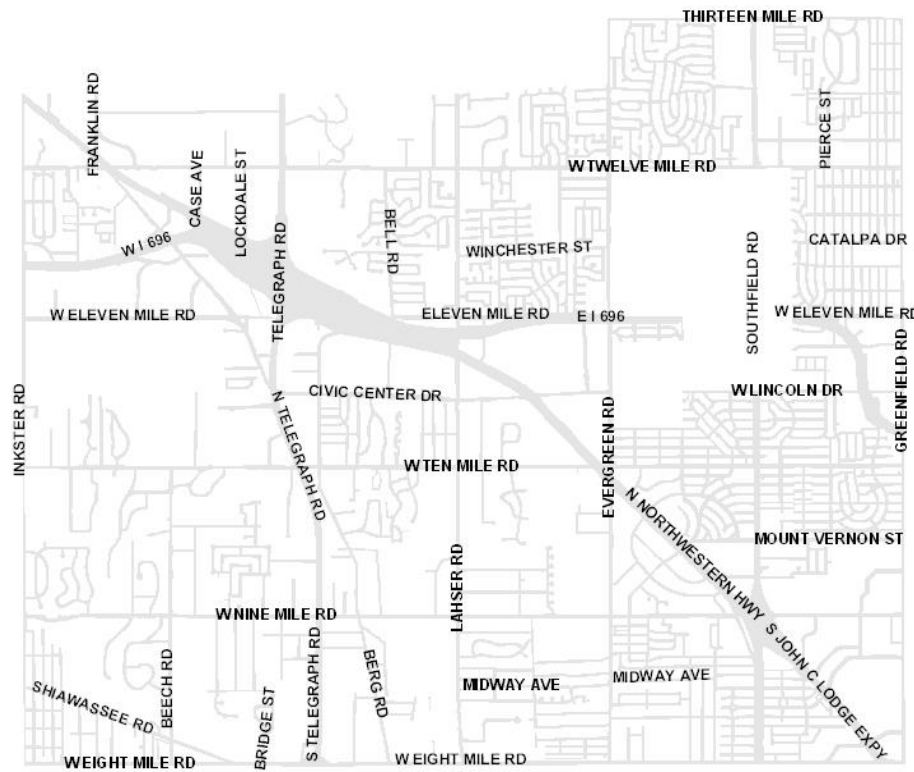

Once inside the apartment suspect(s) removed several electronic items and jewelry. Note: There have been three other incidents in a nearby building since December 2017. This incident is possibly related to the other incidents due to similar characteristics. Electronic items, jewelry and clothing were taken in all the incidents.

Officers discovered good Home Invasion. Entry was through kitchen window. Suspect(s) used a patio chair, climbed up and pulled open the unlocked, partially open kitchen window. The suspect(s) then pushed in the screen and climbed into the house leaving dirt and water on the kitchen counter and floor. It appears that the alarm scared suspect(s) away. The alarm was tripped at 4:42pm. Nothing was missing from the residence.</p>

Officer waited for additional units to arrive and the driver was taken into custody without incident.</p> <p>After the suspect was taken into custody it was later learned that the pickup truck was a stolen vehicle.</p> <p>Victim (Southfield Resident) came into the police station to report his vehicle (Ford Ranger Pickup) was stolen from his driveway this morning. R/p advised the head of security who then spoke with suspect reference the incident. Suspect denied the larceny and R/P decided to notify police.</p> <p>Officer arrived on scene and reviewed surveillance video. It was clear that the security guard took victim's wallet.</p> <p>Victim is unsure if he wants to prosecute because he is from out of town.</p> <p>The wallet was not recovered.</p> <p>Suspect (Security Guard from Hotel) has been identified and incident is under investigation.</p>

It was later discovered that the person that rented this room was a prostitute and she had invited two subjects to her room.</p> <p>Suspect Description: Suspect #1: B/M 6' 4" early 20's wearing black jeans, jacket and shoes. short facial hair. Suspect #2: B/M 5' 9" early 20's wearing black jeans, jacket and boots.</p> <p>Suspect#1 became violent and started to destroy the hotel room when he was denied sex by the prostitute.</p> <p>When victim and another hotel employee showed up at the room Suspect# 1 hit victim and knocked her up against the wall and to the floor. Suspect#1 then started to stomp on victim's head. It wasn't until victim pretended to be dead that Suspect#1 stopped his assault on victim.</p> <p>The second employee, fearing for his safety and fellow workers safety fled to the front desk to call 911.</p> <p>It was reported that Suspect#2 took the prostitutes cell phone before leaving her room. Both suspects fled in a Silver Vehicle.</p> <p>Victim had several injuries but was in stable condition at the hospital.</p> <p>The suspects were not located at the time of reporting.</p> <p>This incident is under investigation.</p>

<p>Special Attention: Reckless Driving/ Threats & Possession of Marijuana Investigation. 02/26/2018 4:58pm 30000 Block of Marshall St. Several Witnesses reported that subject driving 2018 White Dodge Charger was driving reckless, at speeds up to 60- 70mph through the residential neighborhood. One of the witnesses who was outside with her children went out into the street & yelled at the driver to slow down. The vehicle continued past, stopped at Judson Ave, completed a 180 turn at high speed and then came back and drove toward the witnesses and victim. The driver got out of his car and made several threats to harm and kill everyone. He was advised by one of the witnesses to get back in his car and leave. The suspect continued to make threats but eventually left the area prior to the Police arriving. Officers located the suspect in the 13 Mile & Greenfield Rd area at a business. When Officers contacted the subject they immediately detected the smell of marijuana coming from the suspect's vehicle. A Southfield Police K-9 Unit was called to the scene and conducted a sweep of suspects' vehicle. Officers located and stopped suspect vehicle at Acacia and Mulroy. After stopping the vehicle, it was learned that the driver of the vehicle had slashed a tire on victims 2018 Dodge Ram Pick Up Truck and he wanted to press charges. Officers questioned the driver and she admitted to slashing one of victim's tires. The knife she used was recovered and the driver was arrested for MDOP.</p>

Officers searched the vehicle and located suspected marijuana.

A Southfield Police Evidence Technician Field Tested a sample of the suspected marijuana and it tested positive for possible presence of marijuana.

Witnesses state they have video of the Reckless Driving Incident but were unable to provide video now.

The suspect was identified and released pending the issuance of a Warrant for Reckless Driving and Possession of Marijuana.

Samoset Trail & Rougecrest Rd.

On 02/27/2018 at approx. 6:39pm, Officers were dispatched to the area of Samoset Trail and Rougecrest on a suspicious gray vehicle occupied by two people.

Officers located the vehicle and spoke to the two occupants.

There was a strong odor of marijuana coming from the vehicle.

Officers investigation led to the recovery of suspected marijuana.

The passenger in the vehicle made admissions that the marijuana belonged to him. The passenger was given an ordinance violation for Possession of Marijuana.

A Southfield Police Evidence Technician Field Tested a sample of the suspected marijuana. The result was positive for possible presence of marijuana.

Stabbing Investigation:

03/03/2018 7:26pm

26000 Block of Telegraph Rd.

(Hotel)

Officers were dispatched to Convenience Store near Telegraph Rd & Swanson on report of a person with a stab wound at that location.

Officers responded and located victim.

The male was bleeding heavily from his chest.

Officers observed several wounds to the victim's torso. Officers rendered first aid until Southfield Life Unit arrived on scene.

Victim stated he met a girl on Instagram. He went to a room at a nearby hotel and met with the suspect.

Victim states suspect stabbed him while in the room at hotel and then got on the phone with a male.

Victim states he fled the hotel and went to the nearby convenience store where a customer noticed he was bleeding and called the police.

Officers investigating went to the Hotel, checked the room that victim stated he came from and found no evidence of a crime scene.

Officers checked several other rooms and still found no evidence of a crime scene.

Victim's mother stated that her son was picked up by someone in a White Jeep earlier in the day.

Victim states the suspect was a dark skinned black female, she was short and appeared to be around 22 years of age.

Victim was unable to provide any further

Felonious Assault-

1- Arrest

02/28/2018 7:19pm

20000 Block of Lahser Rd.

(Apartments)

Officers responded to location on report of two subjects fighting.

One of the subjects was reportedly armed with a machete.

Officers arrived on scene and located victim who had several lacerations, cuts, puncture wounds and was bleeding badly.

A life Unit responded to scene and transported victim to the Hospital.

Investigation revealed that victim and his brother (suspect) got into a fight because victim was supposed to pick him up from work but couldn't. When suspect got home he took victim's cell phone from him and that's what started the fight. At some point during the fight suspect grabbed a metal object, possibly a machete and hit victim with it numerous times causing serious injury to victim.

The suspect was located and interviewed by Officers.

Suspect made admissions to striking his brother with the metal object.

Suspect was taken into custody for Felonious Assault.
