The male half had removed the car seat from the vehicle and he was attempting to walk home with the baby.

The female half didn't want him to walk home with the baby, it was 15* outside and the two were fighting for possession of the car seat creating a safety issue for the baby in the car seat. The male half at some point gained control of the car seat and baby.

During the struggle for the car seat Officer advised both parties to put the car seat with the baby down. The female complied.

Male half refused so Officers had no choice but to take the subject into custody for Resisting & Obstructing Officers.

The baby and the car seat were secured and turned over to the mother.
