A neighbor called in reference to suspicious footprints in the snow leading up to a broken window at residence.

Officers arrived and observed footprints in the snow leading to the north west side of the property. Alongside the footprints, there appeared to be suspected loose marijuana. Officers approached the house and observed a broken window on the north west corner of the property.

When officers got to the window, they could smell an odor of marijuana emanating from the residence. Officers looked into the residence through the broken window to check for possible suspects or victims.

			<p>Officers observed several large plants of suspected marijuana, lighting and equipment, similar to a marijuana growth operation.</p> <p>There was a brown metal spade shovel under the broken window on the exterior of the residence. Officers believe it was used to break the window. Officers recovered a black plastic bag from the west side of the property, near the footprints in the snow. The bag contained suspected loose marijuana. A Search Warrant was later obtained and entry was made into the residence. Several suspected Marijuana Plants were recovered from the residence. The residence was unoccupied at the time of execution of the Search Warrant. Incident is under investigation.</p>

(Apartments)	Cell Phone, Keys to Vehicle, and a Black Purse were taken.	<p>Victim stated after leaving work she drove home to her apartment located in Southfield After arriving at her apartment complex she sat in her vehicle for approx. 10 minutes as she spoke on her phone.</p> <p>Victim stated she noticed a vehicle pull up on the driver's side of her vehicle and park.</p> <p>Approximately two or three minutes later, she exited her vehicle. At that time, the suspect exited from the front passenger seat and produced a handgun. He pointed it at victims face and stated "Give me your money."</p> <p>The suspect took victims cell phone, keys to her vehicle, and her purse. The suspect then re-entered the vehicle he arrived in and the driver pulled off toward the entrance.
