(Residential- Apartments)</p>	<p>Maintenance key was used.</p>	<p>Victim stated that he left his residence intact on 01/18/2016 at approximately 9:00pm. Upon returning home at 9:00pm on 01/19/2016 he discovered a key was in his door lock. Victim believes the key is a maintenance key. Apartment was ransacked and several items including Flat Screen TV's, Laptop & TV Projector is missing. A Southfield Police Evidence Technician processed the scene and developed Latent Lifts.</p>

R/P stated that he received a call today at 2:10pm, from the agent, advising the lock box on the front door was missing and copper plumbing was missing from the basement. Another nearby vacant residence on Fontana St was also Broken into.</p>

<p>01/22/2016 3:50am</p>	<p>18000 Jeanette St. (Vacant Remodel Residence)</p>	<p>Front door was forced open.</p>	<p>Officers were responding to a residence in the 25000 Block of Parsons on a Home Invasion which just occurred.</p> <p>Upon arrival, Officers observed footprints in the snow leading from the house to the street. The footprints appeared to be athletic shoe prints. The footprints disappeared at the curb near tire tracks. The tire tracks led away from the home.</p> <p>Officers began an area check for possible suspects. Officers located residence that appeared to be another vacant remodel residence in the 18000 Block of Jeanette St.</p> <p>Officers located a vehicle parked in front of this house. It was still warm and there were shoeprints in the snow that matched the shoeprints in the snow at the other residence on Parsons St.</p> <p>Additional Officers responded to this residence. Officers checked the rear of the house. A loud thumping noise could be heard coming from the basement. Officers also observed lights flashing in the basement.</p> <p>Officers checked the front door and discovered that it had been forced open.</p> <p>Several Officers then entered the residence.</p> <p>Two subjects were located in the basement and were taken into custody for Home Invasion.</p> <p>They were in the process of taking copper piping from the basement.</p> <p>Detectives interviewed both subjects and both made admissions to the original Home Invasion on Parsons and also the Home Invasion that they were arrested at</p>
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on Jeannette St.

Both subjects also made admissions to other Home Invasions of vacant residences in Southfield and taking copper piping.

Entry was gained into the residence and two bedrooms were ransacked. Victim states clothing, laptop and camera are missing from the residence.</p>

Suspect is listed in Lein as a Missing/ Runaway and she is believed to be in the company of her boyfriend.
