Special Attention: Landscapers and Lawn Cutters!

Several Landscaping vehicles and trailers have been attacked recently while the workers are away from their vehicles working.

Suspect(s) are taking Trimmers, Edger's, Blowers etc. They are also taking wallets and cell phones from their vehicles when left unlocked.

In one of the incidents victim observed a 2003 Chevy Equinox, Dark Blue in color pulled up to his landscaping trailer. As victim got closer the vehicle fled the scene. Victim could only see that the two suspects were B/M's approx. 35-40yoa.

Special Attention: Larceny from Vehicles

How to prevent this from happening to you!

- Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle.
- If you have a garage you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage.
- If you don't have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible.
- If you here any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately call 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the suspect(s) and suspect vehicles as you can. Stay on the phone with Dispatchers until the Police arrive.
- Keep in mind, in most instances when someone breaks out a window or is attempting to take Wheels & Tires from a vehicle it will emit a loud noise and a loud boom when dropping vehicle to the ground after removing the Wheels & Tires from a vehicle.

Possession of Marijuana/ CCW- 1- Arrest

Officers responded to location on a suspicious vehicle.

Officers located the vehicle. It was occupied and running.

As soon as the occupant saw the police he turned the vehicle off and started to walk away.

Officers stopped the subject. There was a strong odor of marijuana coming from the vehicle and the subject. The subject admitted to smoking marijuana and the likelihood that there was marijuana in the vehicle.

Further investigation by Officers discovered marijuana and a handgun in the center console. The subject didn't have a CPL Permit.

Subject was arrested for Possession of Marijuana and CCW.

A Southfield Police Evidence Technician Field tested the suspected Marijuana. Result was positive for possible presence of marijuana.

Felonious Assault/ Obstruct Police- 1- Arrest

07/17/2016 9:11pm

16000 Block of North Park Drive

Officers were dispatched to the 16000 Block of North Park Drive for an assault with a BB gun. While in route, dispatch advised the victim was shot in the neck with a BB gun.

Victim was located and stated he was playing outside near the tennis courts when an unknown male put a BB gun through the fence and shot him in the neck. He stated he was approximately 30 feet from the Suspect. Victim does not know the shooter and he has never seen him before.

Officers responded to location, conducted an investigation and the suspect was later located. The BB Gun was recovered and the suspect was taken into custody for Felonious Assault.

The suspect gave Officers several alias names and was also charged with Obstructing Officers.
