



Officers arrived and discovered good B&E. The west glass entry doors were smashed in by a vehicle. There were tire tread marks on the pavement leading into the building, the tile flooring and across one of the doors that was pushed inside the business. There was a tail light lens and a car antenna on the sales floor. The lock on the main gate had been cut. An Air Compressor and Several Nail Guns were taken from a side office. The alarm company advised that at 12:20am they observed a Dark Colored Sedan on camera near the side door of the business. At 12:2am they lost sight of the vehicle and received multiple alarm trips from inside the business. The suspect vehicle is believed to be a 2000-2002 Chevrolet Cavalier, Black or Dark Gray in Color and should be missing the left taillight and vehicle antenna.

Victim stated he was trying to buy a cell phone (Samsung) from a guy he met on Facebook. Victim met the two suspects in the 28000 Block of Everett. During the transaction victim got into the suspect's vehicle with them and at some point one of the suspects produced a handgun and robbed victim of his phone and an undisclosed amount of cash. The two suspects fled the scene in a Green Jaguar with a license plate that was put out to Officers. A Southfield Officer observed a Green Jaguar traveling w/b on 10 mile from Greenfield. The vehicle was occupied by 2- B/M's matching the description of the R/A. The plate on the vehicle was also similar to the one given by victim. The vehicle pulled into the Gas Station at 10 mile and Southfield and a felony stop was conducted. The occupants of the vehicle were taken into custody without incident. Officers recovered stolen cell phone, suspected marijuana and the handgun that was used in the Robbery. It was later discovered by Detectives during their interview with adult suspect that he attempted to first pay for the cell phone with counterfeit

- Wheel Locks are a deterrent but don't leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock.	R/A= Robbery Armed PWID= Possession with Intent to Deliver PPO= Personal Protection Order
 If you don't have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible. 	
-If you here any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately call 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the suspect(s) and suspect vehicles as you can. Stay on the phone with Dispatchers until the Police arrive.	

-Keep in mind, in most instances when someone breaks out a window or is attempting to take Wheels & Tires from a vehicle it will emit a loud noise and a loud boom when dropping vehicle to the ground after removing the Wheels & Tires from a vehicle.
