



Date/Time	Address (block range)	Method of Entry	Description/Suspect Information
07/25/2017 3:04am	21000 W Nine Mile Rd. (Commercial- Market)	Front glass window on the north side of store was broken out.	Officers responded to alarm at Market in the 21000 Block of Nine Mile Rd indicating glass breakage. Officer working unmarked unit arrived first and observed glass broken out on front of store and an audible alarm was activated. Officer checked the area and observed a Red Ford Taurus running w/o the headlights activated to the rear of business one east of the market. The vehicle then went south through the alley and stopped at another business on Lahser Rd. It appeared that suspects were attempting to break into this business now. The suspects observed Officer vehicle and they fled s/b on Lahser at a high rate of speed w/o its headlights activated. When the vehicle got to 8 Mile & Lahser it attempted to go e/b on 8 Mile in the w/b lanes. The vehicle lost control and struck the median. One subject bailed and headed n/b, the other occupants bailed and headed s/b. Officer observed a subject in grey hoodie, darker grey pants, and grey mask or shirt covering face running e/b in front of the businesses. Several Officers gave chase. A Southfield Police K-9 Officer involved in the foot pursuit warned suspect several times that if he didn't stop fleeing he would release his K-9. Suspect ignored Officers warnings and continued to flee. The K-9 was released and given the apprehension command. K-9 caught up to suspect and engaged him.

	The suspect was then apprehended by Officers and taken into custody Disposition: Good B&E at Market. Stolen Liquor Bottles, Lottery Tickets and Cigarettes were later recovered in a plastic bag. The second business that was attempted checked secure. The two other suspects that fled the vehicle were not located at this time. The vehicle suspects were in was reported stolen out of another jurisdiction. Evidence relating to and discovered from the stolen vehicle are being investigated that may lead to identifying the other two suspects.

07/29/2017 1:19pm	21000 Poinciana St. (8 Mile & Inkster Area)	Front door was forced open.	Officers responded to Home Invasion in progress. Information from R/P was an unknown B/M wearing a red shirt, forced entry into the home and assaulted her husband. The suspect exited out of the rear sliding door and fled through the back door. Officers arrived and observed male victim to be sitting on the side porch steps, and his wife was standing on the porch landing next to him. Victim had several injuries and was bleeding. R/P (victim's wife) stated she was in the kitchen when she heard a loud noise in the living room and screaming. R/P attempted to call 911 however when the suspect saw she was on the phone he ripped the phone out of her hand, pushed her into the corner of the dining room and told her to be quiet. R/P stated the suspect then returned to her husband and continued to assault him. R/P began screaming, and the suspect again told her to be quiet. Victim yelled to his wife, "Get the gun!" The suspect then pulled all the phones off the walls, disabling them, and fled out the sliding glass door. At this point R/P was able to call 911 and began screaming for help. -Lots of lighting around the area(s) that you park your vehicles is also very beneficial. Criminals don't like to work in well lighted areas. They prefer to work in darkness because it's difficult to see them.

Fleeing & Eluding- 1- Arrest 07/30/2017 9:43pm M-10/ Evergreen Rd. Southfield Officer attempted to initiate a stop for a traffic violation at location. The driver failed to stop and a vehicle pursuit ensued. The suspect eventually pulled over and was placed under arrest without further incident.

PWID Marijuana- 2- Arrests 07/29/2017 5:10pm 27000 Block of Northwestern (Hotel)

Officers were dispatched to Hotel in the 27000 Block of Northwestern Hwy. for a room eviction. Upon arrival, the Officers entered the room with management and discovered a large amount of suspected marijuana inside the room.
