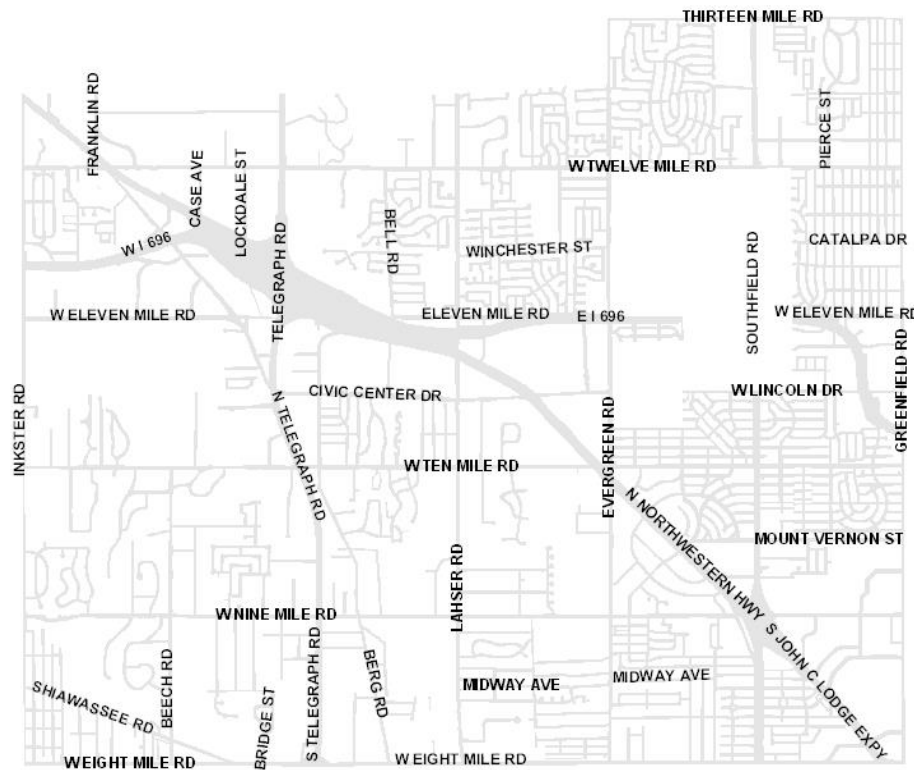

Commercial Burglaries:

Date/Time	Address (block range)	Method of Entry	Description/Suspect Information
07/25/2017 3:04am	21000 W Nine Mile Rd. (Commercial- Market)	Front glass window on the north side of store was broken out.	<p>Officers responded to alarm at Market in the 21000 Block of Nine Mile Rd indicating glass breakage. Officer working unmarked unit arrived first and observed glass broken out on front of store and an audible alarm was activated.</p> <p>Officer checked the area and observed a Red Ford Taurus running w/o the headlights activated to the rear of business one east of the market. The vehicle then went south through the alley and stopped at another business on Lahser Rd.</p> <p>It appeared that suspects were attempting to break into this business now. The suspects observed Officer vehicle and they fled s/b on Lahser at a high rate of speed w/o its headlights activated. When the vehicle got to 8 Mile & Lahser it attempted to go e/b on 8 Mile in the w/b lanes. The vehicle lost control and struck the median.</p> <p>One subject bailed and headed n/b, the other occupants bailed and headed s/b. Officer observed a subject in grey hoodie, darker grey pants, and grey mask or shirt covering face running e/b in front of the businesses. Several Officers gave chase.</p> <p>A Southfield Police K-9 Officer involved in the foot pursuit warned suspect several times that if he didn't stop fleeing he would release his K-9. Suspect ignored Officers warnings and continued to flee. The K-9 was released and given the apprehension command. K-9 caught up to suspect and engaged him.</p>

			<p>The suspect was then apprehended by Officers and taken into custody</p> <p>Disposition: Good B&E at Market. Stolen Liquor Bottles, Lottery Tickets and Cigarettes were later recovered in a plastic bag.</p> <p>The second business that was attempted checked secure. The two other suspects that fled the vehicle were not located at this time.</p> <p>The vehicle suspects were in was reported stolen out of another jurisdiction. Evidence relating to and discovered from the stolen vehicle are being investigated that may lead to identifying the other two suspects.</p>

Be on the Look Out Highlights:	Arrests by SPD Officers:
<p>Special Attention: LFA's Special Attention: Larceny from Vehicles How to prevent this from happening to you!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!) - If you have a garage you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage. - Wheel Locks are a deterrent but don't leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock. -After parking your vehicle turn your wheels all the way to the right or the left. This will make it difficult to get the lug nuts off the front wheels. - If you don't have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible. -If you here any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately call 911, (Do Not Approach 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> OWI= Operate While Impaired OUI= Operate Under Influence Narcotics LFA= Larceny From Auto R&C= Receiving & Concealing Stolen Property DWLS= Driving With Suspended License A&B= Assault & Battery CSC= Criminal Sexual Conduct CCW/CPL= Carrying Concealed Weapon NOLOP= No Operator License on Person R/A= Robbery Armed PWID= Possession with Intent to Deliver PPO= Personal Protection Order

or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the suspect(s) and suspect vehicles as you can. Stay on the phone with Dispatchers until the Police arrive.

-Lots of lighting around the area(s) that you park your vehicles is also very beneficial. Criminals don't like to work in well lighted areas. They prefer to work in darkness because it's difficult to see them.
