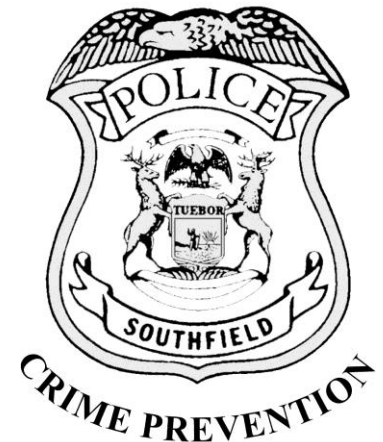

**Commercial Burglaries:**

07/06/2016 2:33am	18000 W Eight Mile Rd.	The front door frame and glass were pushed in and smashed where a vehicle had struck the entrance.	<p>Officers were dispatched to Grocery Store in the 18000 Block of 8 Mile Rd for a B&amp;E. Both main entry doors were shattered and pushed in by a truck. At 2:33am Video Surveillance shows the suspect vehicle come into view. Several people exit the vehicle near the front of the business and hide behind the brick pillars outside the main entrance. At 2:34am the suspect vehicle backs through the exterior sliding glass door entrance/exit of the vestibule/cart area. The vehicle then backs through the interior sliding glass door entrance/exit of the store. Three suspects wearing all black clothing, hoodies, with gloves and masks enter from outside and tear the ATM from its floor mounts. The 4th suspect (driver) clears the broken glass doors from the truck bed during this time. The ATM machine is dragged into the vestibule and loaded into the truck bed. Three suspects enter the single cab pickup and the 4th lies down in the bed area with the ATM. The suspects drive out of the business at 2:35am. The suspect vehicle was not located at this time.</p>

07/06/2016 3:23pm	30000 Brentwood St.	Attempt on front door.	Victim advises he owes suspect an undisclosed amount of money. Suspect came to victim's house to collect his money. When victim told suspect he didn't have the money suspect allegedly attempted to gain entry into victim's house. Suspect was located at his residence. Suspect confirmed that he went to victim's residence to collect money that was owed to him. Suspect states the door was damaged when victim slammed the door on him. Suspect was identified and released pending further investigation.

Upon arrival, Officers observed that the garage door was opened approximately one foot off of the ground and that the door going from the garage into the residence was opened. Officers recovered a Purse and Miscellaneous Coins in the driveway in front of the garage door. A Southfield Police K-9 Officer cleared the residence. Nobody was found inside the residence. Victim's bedroom was ransacked. Victim states several items were missing from her bedroom.</p>

Victim states the following morning at 6:00am he received a blocked phone call from an unknown female who told him she found some misc. documents from his vehicle in front of her yard in the street. The unknown female caller went on to say she was awakened around 5:45am by a Gray Dodge Charger parked in front of her house with two black males in it. The occupants were throwing paper items out of it. The vehicle pulled away minutes later and she retrieved the documents. On July 10, 2016 Detroit Auto recovery contacted Southfield Dispatch and informed them that they recovered the vehicle that was stolen out of Southfield. The vehicle was impounded by DPD. There were no arrests made and the registered owner was contacted.</p>

Officers responded to Hospital regarding a women screaming for help. The male suspect was taken into custody for Domestic Assault and Possession of a Firearm while intoxicated.  
The handgun was recovered in plain view in the suspects' vehicle. Officers obtained a Search Warrant to have hospital personnel take blood from suspect.

(Bus Stop)

Officers were dispatched to Bus Stop on a drug complaint. An anonymous R/P called police to report that a subject was selling marijuana at the Bus Stop.

Officers arrived on scene and immediately located the suspect. After interviewing suspect he consented to a search.

Officers located a plastic baggie in suspect's crotch area containing several individually wrapped corner ties with suspected marijuana.

A Southfield Police Evidence Technician Field Tested a sample of the suspected marijuana. The result was positive for possible presence of marijuana.

There was also a sum of money that was confiscated and forfeited from suspect.
