


Officers were dispatched to Grocery Store in the 18000 Block of 8 Mile Rd for a B&E. Both main entry doors were shattered and pushed in by a truck. At 2:33am Video Surveillance shows the suspect vehicle come into view. Several people exit the vehicle near the front of the business and hide behind the brick pillars outside the main entrance. At 2:34am the suspect vehicle backs through the exterior sliding glass door entrance/exit of the vestibule/cart area. The vehicle then backs through the interior sliding glass door entrance/exit of the store. Three suspects wearing all black clothing, hoodies, with gloves and masks enter from outside and tear the ATM from its floor mounts. The 4th suspect (driver) clears the broken glass doors from the truck bed during this time. The ATM machine is dragged into the vestibule and loaded into the truck bed. Three suspects enter the single cab pickup and the 4th lies down in the bed area with the ATM. The suspects drive out of the business at 2:35am. The suspect vehicle was not located at this time.

The male suspect was taken into custody for Domestic Assault and Possession of a Firearm while intoxicated.

The handgun was recovered in plain view in the suspects' vehicle. Officers obtained a Search Warrant to have hospital personnel take blood from suspect.

The three suspects all had flashlights and stolen items from several of the vehicles that were attacked.

The three suspects were arrested and lodged for Larceny from Auto and Possession of the Stolen Bicycles.
