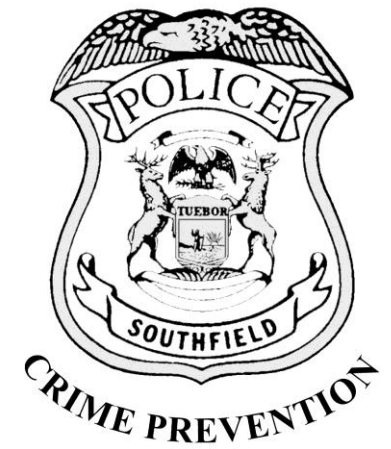
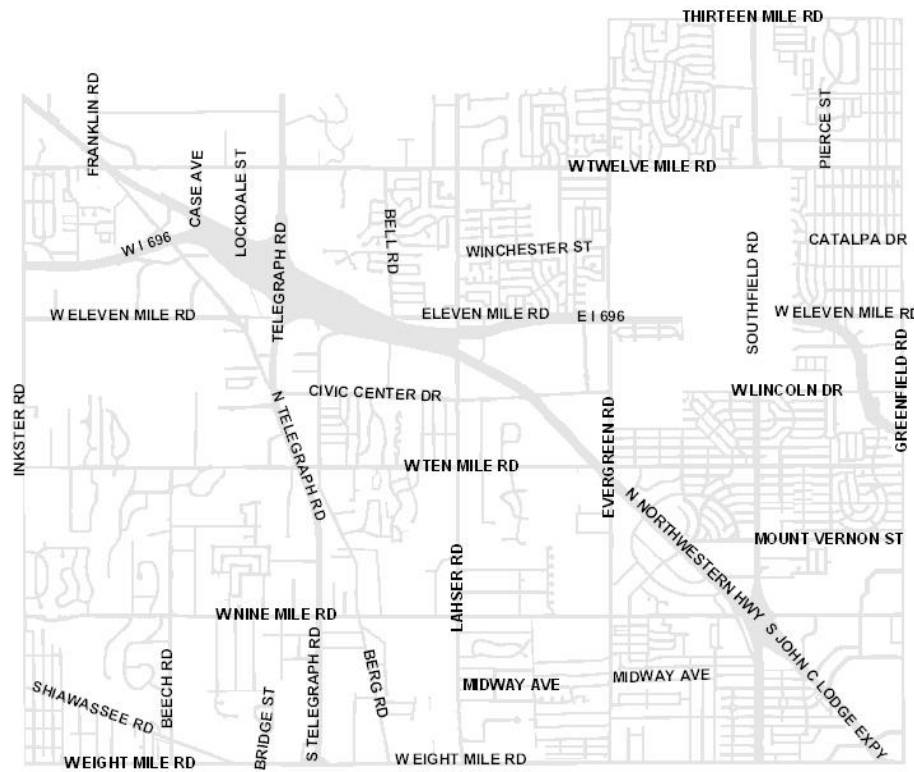

## Commercial Burglaries:

While in the backyard with one of the suspects a second suspect went into victim's residence and stole items.</p>	<p>Victim stated that she was out working in her front yard shortly after 4:30pm. Victim was approached by a white female along with a small child. The female stated that they were looking for a lost cat and that they recently had moved into a home just up the street. Female used the ruse about the lost cat to get victim to go into her back yard to look for the cat. A short time later after female left victim discovered that someone had entered her residence and stolen several articles of jewelry. Victim described the female as late 20's to early 30's, approximately 5'-4" to 5'-5" and weighed 130- 140 lbs. The female identified herself by the name Lisa. She had shoulder length straight black hair with a darker than normal complexion. Victim believes she may be Hispanic. Victim stated that the female had an 8-9 year old boy with her. He also had a dark complexion with short black hair. Victim believed he was wearing tan shorts. The child was introduced as Josh.</p>
