

Anyone that hears a loud boom during these times should attempt to look outside without being detected to see if there is any activity around their vehicles or someone else's vehicle.

The loud boom is created after suspects remove the tires & wheels from one side of the vehicle.

The vehicle is then dropped down onto landscaping bricks usually causing the loud boom.

Anyone witnessing this should immediately call 911 and give the Southfield Police Dispatcher as much information as they can about the suspects and the suspect's vehicle.
