Inspection of surrounding area by Officers revealed that there are several areas along the fence surrounding the property that have been compromised.

Officers observed Suspect #1, smash out the door with a dark colored crowbar with a white hook. Suspect #1 made entry into the building and waited for Suspect #2 to enter the building. Both suspects approached the pharmacy from the south side of the building. Once inside both suspects ran to the rear of the counter checking shelves and two drawers that contained empty pill bottles. Suspect #1 went into a rear office and immediately came out. Both suspects then fled the store. Suspect's entered the pharmacy at 5:07am and exited the pharmacy at 5:08am.
