The owner arrived and was able to review the surveillance video. The video shows an unknown person entering through a window. A short time later the same subject is seen leaving the building. (Suspects were out of the vehicle standing in the driveway on the side of the house)</p> <p>Officer walked up near suspect's vehicle and observed a cell phone and cash inside the vehicle lying on the seats.</p> <p>The suspects were uncooperative and animated when questioned about incident.</p> <p>Basically denied everything and had no idea how</p>
