Dispatch advised that they had received multiple calls from the residents in the Apartment Complex regarding gun shots being heard in the area.</p> <p>Officers arrived on scene and immediately encountered a subject that was later identified as an (Oakland County Parolee), holding a handgun in his right hand. Officers lost sight of this subject as he fled around a corner. While looking for this subject Officers observed another subject later identified carrying an AK assault type rifle. He was ordered to the ground. In speaking with this subject it was learned that he was on probation. This subject stated he was inside his home when he heard 4-5 gun shots, and seconds later, the subject that Officers had first seen running with a handgun in his hand told him that someone was shooting at another associate of theirs.</p> <p>Subject told officers that the suspects left the scene before he was able to make contact. Officers made contact with subject observed earlier running with handgun after he emerged from the wooded area.</p> <p>The handgun this subject was alleged to have had was found discarded in the area he was seen in and the gun was confiscated.</p> <p>Officers also spoke with alleged victim who</p>

			<p>stated that he pulled into a parking lot of complex and unknown suspect walked up to him with a handgun and said, "Don't Move". Victim states he ran and the suspect shot at him. Officers responded to business on a report of Security Officers fighting with two Retail Fraud Suspects who were trying to escape.

Officers arrived on scene and assisted Security and store employees who were detaining two suspects. One male and one female.

The male suspect had been observed by security walking out of the store with two chainsaws. When Security attempted to stop suspect he resisted Security and accessed & activated a Taser that he had in the pocket of his hoodie. Security was able to stop suspect from tasing them by holding his arms. (Taser was recovered by Officers)

Suspect's female companion then pulled up in a vehicle and pepper sprayed Security.

Southfield Officers arrived and both suspects were taken into custody.

Victim and suspect got into a verbal argument. Suspect became upset and started punching victim with his fist. Victim tried to run out of the hotel room when he hit her with a luggage rack. Victim was able to escape to her vehicle and locked the car doors. Suspect then jumped on top of victim's vehicle damaging the hood and windshield. Officers arrived on scene located suspect and took him into custody for Agg. /Felony Assault.
