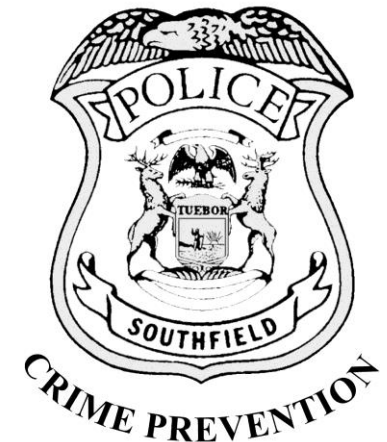
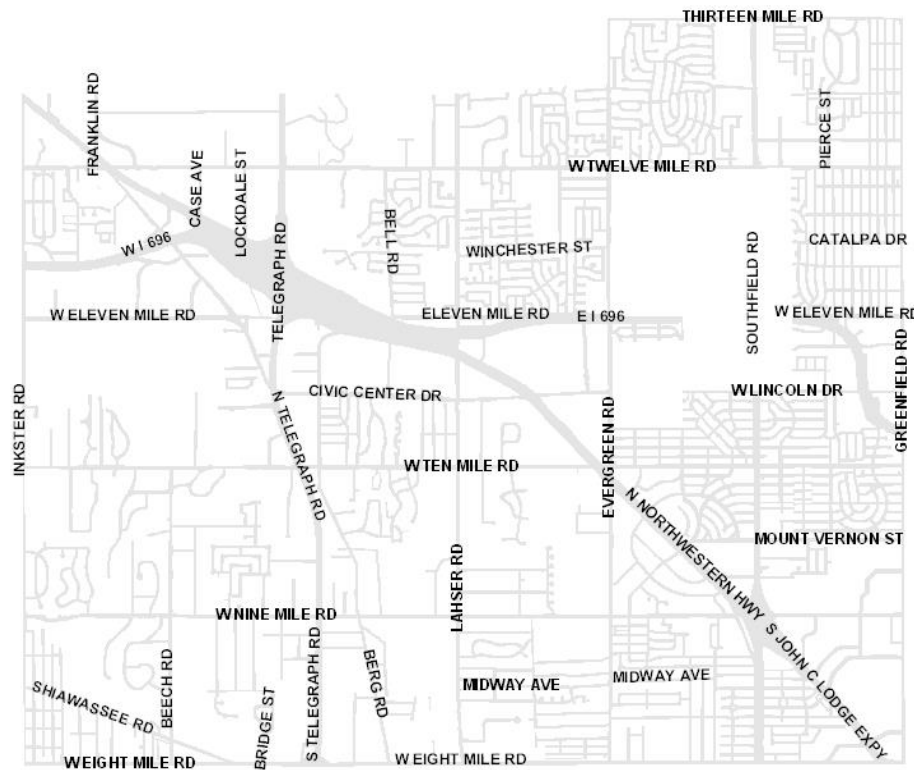

06/14/2015 1:43pm	15000 Town Ctr. (Hotel)	Hotel Door was pried open.	Victim left her Hotel Room in Southfield last night and got a hotel room in downtown Detroit for the night. Victim stated she returned the next day to extend her stay at the Hotel in Southfield around 1:15pm when she noticed her door was open. Victim went into the room and discovered the safe was ripped out of the wall and her suitcases were taken. The safe reportedly contained several items of value.

06/14/2015 3:14am	29000 Pointe O Woods (Apartments)	Jewelry, Cash, Cell Phones, & Credit Cards were taken from victims.	<p>Victims, both females, state they had spent the night clubbing in Detroit.</p> <p>Victims returned to Southfield and went to a Taco Bell intending to order food. After seeing that the line was too long they decided to go home and they would cook something there.</p> <p>The victims returned home to one of the victims apartment complex located in the 29000 Block of 12 Mile Rd.</p> <p>As they were preparing to exit the vehicle, Suspect#1, a B/M wearing a dark tee-shirt pulled open the driver's side door and pointed a handgun at victim#1.</p> <p>Suspect#2, a B/M wearing a white tee-shirt, opened the passenger side door and demanded victim#2 purse. Victim#2 began to scream and Suspect#2 told her to shut up and to free her arm as he pulled on her purse.</p> <p>Both victims stated that they observed a third B/M, Suspect#3, sitting in the driver's seat of a White Chrysler 300 (2005 or later model).</p> <p>Suspect#3 had a black bandana covering his face.</p> <p>Note: Officers noted that victim's vehicle reeked of marijuana.</p>
