



Officers responded to the 27000 Block of Northwestern Highway (Hotel). The front desk clerk called and advised a woman staying at the hotel advised him to call the police because there was a male friend inside the room with her who was making her uncomfortable, and he would not leave upon request. The female believed the male may have a weapon inside his bag in the room.

Officers arrived on scene and contacted subject. He was advised he had to leave the room & he complied.

After obtaining suspects ID, Officers discovered the suspect had a Felony Warrant out of neighboring jurisdiction for Assault with Intent to do Great Bodily Harm.

The warrant was confirmed and the suspect was taken into custody. During the search incident to the arrest Officers recovered several pills believed to be Ecstasy.

• Ask for credit or debit card numbers over the phone.

Always use trusted sites and be careful when clicking.

When using an online tax preparation service, look for the tax preparer identification number. The IRS requires all paid tax preparers to have one before filing any returns.
