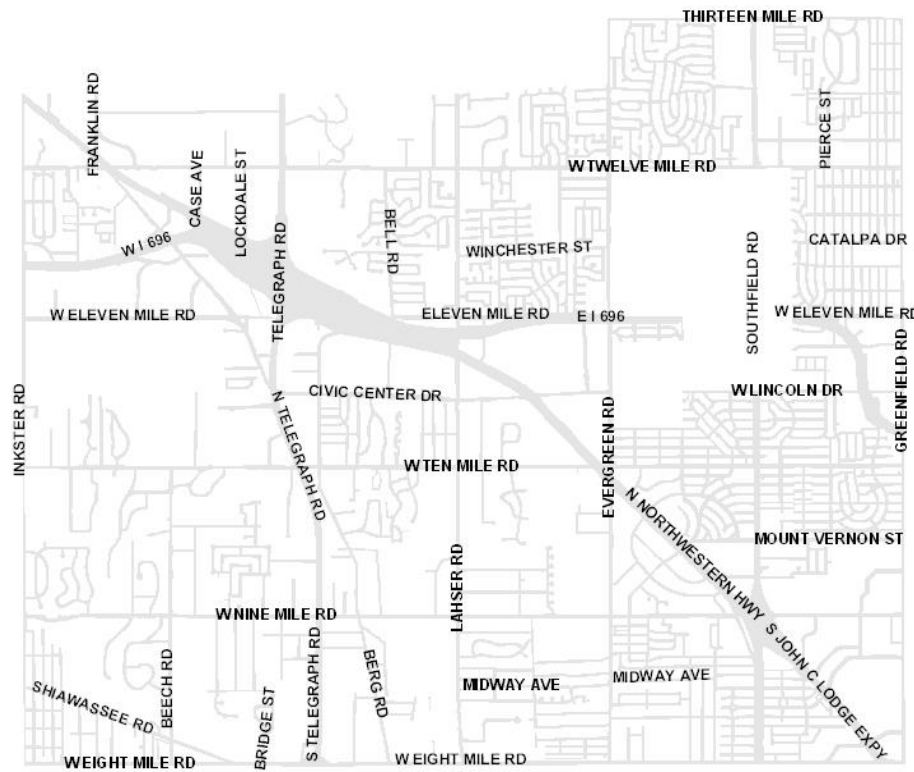

03/28/2019 3:02am	15000 W Eleven Mile Rd. (Commercial- Party Shoppe)	Window broken out with Sledge Hammer.	<p>Officers were dispatched to the 15000 Block of Eleven Mile Rd. (Party Shoppe) on report of window being broken out in progress.</p> <p>Officers arrived on scene and discovered good B&amp;E. Officers were later met by Berkley Officers that advised they had earlier stopped a vehicle in their city that they believe may have been involved in this B&amp;E. A review of surveillance video by Berkley Officers confirmed suspect vehicle and suspects in our B&amp;E were a match to the vehicle and suspects they stopped earlier. The two suspects were identified by Berkley PD during their stop.</p> <p>Based on this information the suspect vehicle and suspects were later located and taken into custody for B&amp;E.</p>

**(Residential- Apartments)**

Officers were dispatched to 27000 Block of Franklin Rd (Apartments) on a CSC Investigation. The victim had run from the apartment building and flagged down a citizen to call the Police.

Officers met with victim who advises she met suspect on Instagram and agreed to meet with him.

Victim met with suspect in the lobby and she went with him to his apartment. There was no furniture in the apartment and she assume he was single.

The two started to talk, which led to interaction between the two. At some point during the interaction suspect wanted to have sex with victim. Victim stated "No" to suspect. Suspect attempted to force himself on female, became upset and assaulted victim. He then told victim to get her stuff and get out.

Victim stated she was in fear and quickly grabbed her things and ran out the door.

Officers attempted to locate suspect and received information that he was at the club house working out. The suspect fled out the back door when he saw Police coming. Suspect has been identified and incident is under investigation.

Always use trusted sites and be careful when clicking. When using an online tax preparation service, look for the tax preparer identification number. The IRS requires all paid tax preparers to have one before filing any returns.
