


The Southfield Police Department is requesting the assistance of the public in identifying a suspect responsible for robbing the Bank located in the 27000 Block of Lahser Road in Southfield. The subject entered the bank on March 22, 2018 at approximately 4:40 p.m. and gave a bank teller a note demanding money.

The subject is described as an African American male, 20-30 years of age, 5'-8"-5'-10", medium length wavy hair, wearing a beige zip-up jacket with pockets, dark pants, sunglasses, and a dark bag with an over-the-shoulder strap.

The suspect fled the bank on foot after the robbery. No one was injured during the incident.
