


R/P stated she was sitting at her security desk that is located on the first floor in the center of the Office Building. R/P stated two B/M's wearing all black entered the building using an access card. Once they were inside the office building they threw a brick through the window breaking out the 4' X 8' glass window on the west side of the building. The two suspects then dragged the ATM Machine out through the window and into a white van. The white van had no windows or logos on it and fled the scene. R/P stated once they first entered she thought they were workers since they had an access card. R/P ran upstairs and called 911 after they broke out window. The suspect vehicle was recovered by DPD after they responded to a vehicle fire in their city. Arson Investigators arrived and discovered the vehicle plate and partially burned vin number. The vehicle was eventually identified via the plate and vin as being a stolen vehicle. It was a complete burn of the vehicle leaving nothing behind except the remnants of the ATM machine. The vehicle exited the complex where a third Officer made intentional contact to stop the fleeing vehicle. The vehicle came to rest on the grassy median on Providence Dr. The driver attempted to flee on foot but was apprehended by Officers. All three suspects were taken into custody for LFA. The driver was arrested for Fleeing & Eluding and No Driver's

			License. Officers recovered a SawZaw and three catalytic converters from the suspect vehicle. The scene was processed by Southfield Police Evidence Technicians. Southfield Detectives interviewed all three suspects. It was discovered that two of the recovered catalytic converters, one each were taken in Oak Park and Ferndale.
