

Subject: News Release

On April 6, 2018 at approximately 1:30 p.m., the Southfield Police Department responded to Apartment Complex in the 27000 block of Greenfield Road regarding a Home Invasion. Video surveillance captured a black male suspect, approximately 6'0", heavy set, bald, with a mustache and goatee and pierced ears entering the home by forcing the front door open. Some of the items that were stolen include: miscellaneous jewelry, small electronics, a 43-inch Visio TV, and a 55-inch Samsung TV. The suspect also stole the family's pet dog, a 9-monthold brown and white American Bully. The dog's name is Gucci.

In the early morning of November 26, 2011, the Highland Park Police Department responded to a vehicle fire in the alley behind the 100-block of W. Buena Vista, Highland Park, Michigan. After the fire department extinguished the fire, they located a body in the backseat burned beyond recognition. A check with the Michigan Secretary of State revealed that the vehicle belonged to Helen Gale, an eightyfemale resident of Southfield. one-year-old Michigan. The body was identified through dental records and it was determined that it was in-fact Helen Gale. The investigation revealed that the fire was intentionally set and the death was classified as a homicide. The case was investigated by the Southfield Police Department and an arrest was made on January 16, 2012, however, a warrant request was not approved at that time and investigators continued investigating the homicide.

In 2017, the Southfield Police Department requested the assistance of the Oakland County Sheriff's Office Special Investigations Unit, along with the Sheriff's Office Cold Case Unit. Further investigation produced additional information and evidence that 52-year-old **Darrin Bruce Keener**, the former next-

The suspect was taken into custody for Domestic Felonious Assault.

door neighbor of Ms. Gale, was responsible for her murder and the burning of her body and vehicle.

The complete investigation was reviewed by the Oakland County Prosecutor's Office. Based on their review of the investigation the Prosecutor's Office authorized an arrest warrant for Darrin Keener for (1) count of Open Murder (Felony up to life) and (1) count of Mutilation of a body (Felony 10 years).

On May 11, 2018 at approximately 10:00 a.m., The United States Marshals Service – Northern District of Ohio, located and arrested suspect Darrin Bruce Keener at his residence in Toledo, Ohio. Keener was lodged at the Lucas County jail in Toledo, Ohio without incident. Keener waived extradition to Oakland County and a video arraignment was held on May 14, 2018 in the 46th District Court in Southfield, Michigan.

Keener was charged with one count of Homicide-Open Murder-Statutory Short Form and one count of Disinterment and Mutilation of Dead Bodies. The case is assigned to the Honorable Shelia Johnson, Keener is scheduled to appear for a Probable Cause Conference on May 23, 2018 at 1:30 p.m. and a Preliminary Examination on May 30, 2018 at 1:30 p.m., both in front of Judge Johnson. Keener indicated that he will retain his own attorney. Bond was denied and there is a condition that Keener not have any contact with any witness or family member

Special Attention: Larceny from Vehicles How to prevent this from happening to you!

- -Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!)
- If you have a garage you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage.
- Wheel Locks are a deterrent but don't leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock.
- -After parking your vehicle turn your wheels all the way to the right or the left. This will make it difficult to get the lug nuts off the front wheels.
- -If you don't have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible.
- -If you here any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately call 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the suspect(s) and suspect vehicles as you can. Stay on the phone with Dispatchers until the Police arrive.

Special Attention:

Larceny of Packages that were ordered and delivered via Common Carrier. How to prevent this from happening to you!

Recently several citizens have had packages that were delivered to their residences and apartments stolen prior to them retrieving the packages. Citizens can prevent this from happening by scheduling a specific time to have the package delivered and be waiting for the package. Citizen can also schedule the package to be picked up by themselves at the common carrier facility.

-Lots of lighting around the area(s) that you park your vehicles is also very beneficial. Criminals don't like to work in well lighted areas. They prefer to work in darkness because it's difficult to see them.
