The suspect started to open the window but was unable to open the window due to a 12 inch metal rod stuck between the two windows, preventing it from being completely opened. One of the suspects deactivated the alarm by putting in the alarm code.</p> <p>The suspects targeted only the firearms in victim's bedroom upstairs. They passed on several other valuables inside the residence.</p> <p>Victim's wife came home, reviewed surveillance video and positively identified one of the suspects as a relative. She thinks the second suspect resembles her son. Victim's son and nephew are presently living together in Detroit with their Grandmother.</p> <p>Victim advises her son has code for alarm.</p> <p>Victims went to Grandmothers house and met with the Grandmother. Victims recovered items that were stolen from Home Invasion in Southfield.</p> <p>On 05/05/2016 at 4:45pm Officers who had set up surveillance at Grandmothers House observed one of the suspects with back pack exit residence and enter a vehicle. The vehicle was stopped and investigated. Two subjects were taken into custody after Officers recovered handguns that both suspects possessed that were taken from the Home Invasion in Southfield.</p> <p>Officers also located the victim's son, believed to be involved in Southfield Home Invasion. He was located walking down the street near the Grandmothers house.</p> <p>Southfield Police Detectives interviewed suspects and as a result of those interviews some of the firearms that were taken in the Southfield Home Invasion were recovered at a residence in Detroit.</p>

## Possession of Marijuana/ Resist & Obstruct Officer- 1- Arrest

Officer stopped vehicle for Traffic Violation. The vehicle was occupied by three subjects.

During the stop it became obvious that the front seat passenger was attempting to chew and consume suspected marijuana. Several particles of suspected marijuana were falling from suspect's mouth, onto his lap and around his seat.

The passenger didn't possess a marijuana card and he was ordered from the vehicle.

Officer stopped a vehicle for travelling well above the posted speed limit. Upon speaking with the driver it was apparent that he had been consuming intoxicating beverages.
