


Tips:			A Southfield Police K-9 Unit was called in to do a track. The track started in the area where the suspects were last seen climbing over the wall into the neighboring Apartment Complex. K-9 acquired a scent and began tracking. Several items belonging to suspects were recovered along the track into the neighboring Apartment Complex. K-9 continued tracking to the front door of an Apartment in the 29000 Block of Twelve Mile Rd. Officers attempted to make contact at this residence but no contact was made. Incident is under investigation.

Officers responded to location on report of a subject with a knife. Officer's investigation revealed that there were several subjects at the residence. One of the subjects accused victim of having sex with his girlfriend. Suspect then picked up a knife, held victim down on the ground and yelled "I'm going to kill you".
