The morning manager arrived at approx. 4:20am and found the backdoor wide open and could see the office door inside the business open as well.</p> <p>Officers arrived on scene and cleared the business. Video surveillance shows at approx. 3:47am, an unknown male dressed in all dark clothing approached the business from the north. The suspect attempted to gain access to the back door by prying it open. The suspect was unsuccessful and moved to the glass front door on the south side of the building. The suspect struck the glass door with some sort of hammer. The glass from both doors shattered and the suspect gained access into the business.</p> <p>The suspect proceeded to the office area immediately upon entry. The suspect attempted to pry open the office door. After approx. two minutes of prying the door, he gained entry. R/p reports that cash was taken from two cash drawers.</p> <p>The suspect was described as a stocky male, dressed in all dark clothing and was wearing a hooded sweatshirt and gloves.</p>

<p><b>Special Attention: MDOP to Vehicle</b>  06/02/2019 5:37am  27000 Northwestern Hwy  <b>(Hotel)</b>  R/P (employee) stated she observed the suspect walk into the front lobby and ask what room her husband was in. (She suspected he was cheating on her) R/P stated she could not provide customer information to her. The suspect began snooping around the hotel lot in search of her husband. A short time later R/P observed suspect standing by a Red Cadillac (husband's vehicle) in the parking lot. R/P then observed suspect run into the building and pull the fire alarm. R/P was unable to locate suspect after that.  Officers inspected the attacked vehicle. Damage to the vehicle included key marks on both sides of the vehicle that run through the entire length of the vehicle. The word "Cheater" was carved in the hood of the vehicle. Officer located the vehicle in the 27000 Block of W Eight Mile Rd. (Oil Change) Officer observed the vehicle being pulled into the garage area of the business. The wanted vehicle was a White Mercedes Benz. The vehicle's license plate matched the plate Dearborn Heights put out as their wanted vehicle.  As additional Officers arrived on scene Officers heard a noise from inside the business. The owner of the business was on scene which was unusual because it was 1:29am. The owner was advised by Officers that the vehicle parked inside his business was involved in a Fleeing &amp; Eluding. The owner gave Officers verbal permission to search the business. After there was no response Officers went down the stairs and located suspect crouching in the corner, hiding from Officers. The suspect was reluctant to come out and to show Officers his hands when ordered to. Officers grabbed onto both of suspects arms and took him into custody.</p>

Officers observed suspect entering an Orange Dodge Charger at the Gas Station at 10 Mile & Evergreen Rd. Officers attempted to stop the vehicle for a traffic violation at Evergreen & Civic Center Rd. The driver failed to stop and a pursuit ensued. The pursuit was terminated after the vehicle fled S/B on the Southfield Freeway South of 8 Mile Rd.

**Suspect Vehicle:**

Orange Dodge Charger was a newer model (2017-18). The vehicle had no visible plate on it, and the driver side tail light was out.

**Suspect Description:**

The suspect was a dark-skinned B/M wearing an all- black sweatshirt with white lettering on it and dark colored pants. The suspect had a shorter Afro haircut and shorter goatee. The suspect was 23-28 years of age and medium build approx. 6ft.

He was handcuffed without further incident.

While handcuffing suspect, he made omissions to running from the police. He said he didn't want to go to jail for his outstanding warrants.

Officers searched suspect and located three pills on his person. They were identified as Controlled Substances.

The suspect was later interviewed by Southfield Detective.

The suspect made admissions to fleeing from Dearborn Heights PD.

The suspect also called his parents after the incident and his father met him at his Oil Change Business and let him into the business to park his car. The father was aware of the incident in Dearborn Heights, contrary to what he told Officers.

Detective Wojciechowski secured warrants for Possession of Controlled Substances and DWLS.

Fleeing & Eluding charges will be handled by Dearborn Heights.

**24000 Block of Templar Ave.**

Several Officers responded to report of shots fired in the 24000 Block of Templar Ave. Information was given that the suspect vehicle was a Black Buick last seen N/B on Templar, occupied by 2 B/M's.

Victim states he was walking up his driveway when a subject known to him drove up to the front of his house and started threatening him and his family. Victim stated he grabbed a landscaping brick from the front yard garden, and hit the subject in the head with it. The subject drove off.

Victim states the subject came back with his brother and drove by his house several times yelling threats at him about his family. During one of the passes the brother had a handgun and shot at victim.

The suspects drove by the house a second time and shot at victim again. This time the victim returned fire at the suspects. Victim was unsure if he hit the suspect's vehicle.

The two suspects were located and they stated they didn't shoot at victim, that it was the victim that shot at them? No handguns were recovered from either suspect. The victim's handgun was confiscated as evidence. Southfield Police Evidence Technicians were on scene searching the area for evidence.

Investigation is on-going.
