Possession of Drug Paraphernalia/ Resist Obstruct Officer-
1- Arrest

Civic Center Dr. & Evergreen Rd.

Officers were dispatched on a possible Robbery just occurred in the area of Civic Center & Evergreen Rd.

While in route there was an update broadcasted that the victim seemed confused about the location and thought he was on Southfield Rd.

Officers located subject standing on the other side of the fence (Freeway side) on Northwestern Service drive just North of Civic Center.

Officers questioned subject and it appeared that he was high on something, intoxicated or both and subject didn't have all his faculties. Officer then told the subject he was going to get patted down for Officer Safety due to the circumstances of the call.

The subject refused to allow Officer to pat him down and immediately started to grab at something in his pocket.

Officer observed a shiny cylinder shaped object in subject's pocket and feared that subject may have a weapon. The subject continued to resist Officer until a second Officer arrived and the subject was taken into custody.

The shiny object turned out to be a crack pipe.

The subject is currently on Parole for Home Invasion and CSC.

The suspect is a Southfield Resident and was arrested for Possession of Drug Paraphernalia/ Resist Obstruct Officer.

The original call about a Robbery was never substantiated.

Several Southfield Officers were working traffic control for a 5-K Run in the area of 10 Mile & Lahser Rd.

Officers witnessed suspect vehicle rear end another vehicle moments after several participants in 5-K Run had passed through the intersection.

The suspect vehicle continued down the roadway and struck a marked police vehicle that was blocking traffic and fled the scene e/b on 10 Mile Rd.

Officers pursued vehicle, lights & siren activated. The suspect vehicle continued fleeing with one of its tires flattened from previous accidents.

Suspect vehicle struck another vehicle in the area of 10 Mile & Evergreen Rd. When suspect vehicle attempted to go N/B on Northwestern Service a Southfield Officer made intentional contact with the vehicle to end the pursuit and the vehicle and the pursuit came to a stop.

The suspect was taken into custody and was transported to hospital for possible injuries and Blood Draw.

The suspect exhibited that he was either high on something or a combination of drugs and alcohol. The suspect was spitting and crying out for help. He did state that he was on Heroin.

The suspect was RPI'd after being admitted into the hospital for his injuries.

Suspect is looking at charges for Leaving the Scene of Accident, DWLS, OWI or OWID, & Fleeing & Eluding.

CSC-1/ Resist Arrest/ Obstruct Officer- 1- Arrest

(Hotel)

Southfield Officers were dispatched to the Hotel to investigate possible Fail to Pay Taxi Driver.

After initiating their investigation additional information was developed that a CSC 1 may have occurred at the Hotel.

The suspect who was being interviewed was highly intoxicated and made admissions to smoking some weed.

At some point the subject became disorderly and when Officers attempted to take suspect into custody he attempted to flee.

Officers apprehended suspect and he continued to resist until Officers were able to get him handcuffed and take him into custody.

Further investigation into possible CSC, Officers discovered a 15 year old female that was originally in one of the hotel rooms with suspect.

The female's mother was contacted and Officers were advised by mother that her 15 year old daughter is cognitively impaired and in special education classes at her school.

The female stated that suspect had sex with her after she told him she was only 15 years old and wanted to go home.

Further investigation led to additional charges for CSC 1.

Suspect was arrested and lodged.
