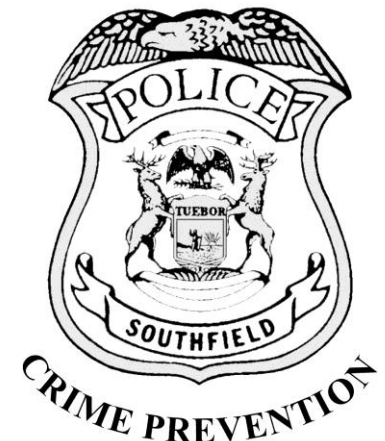
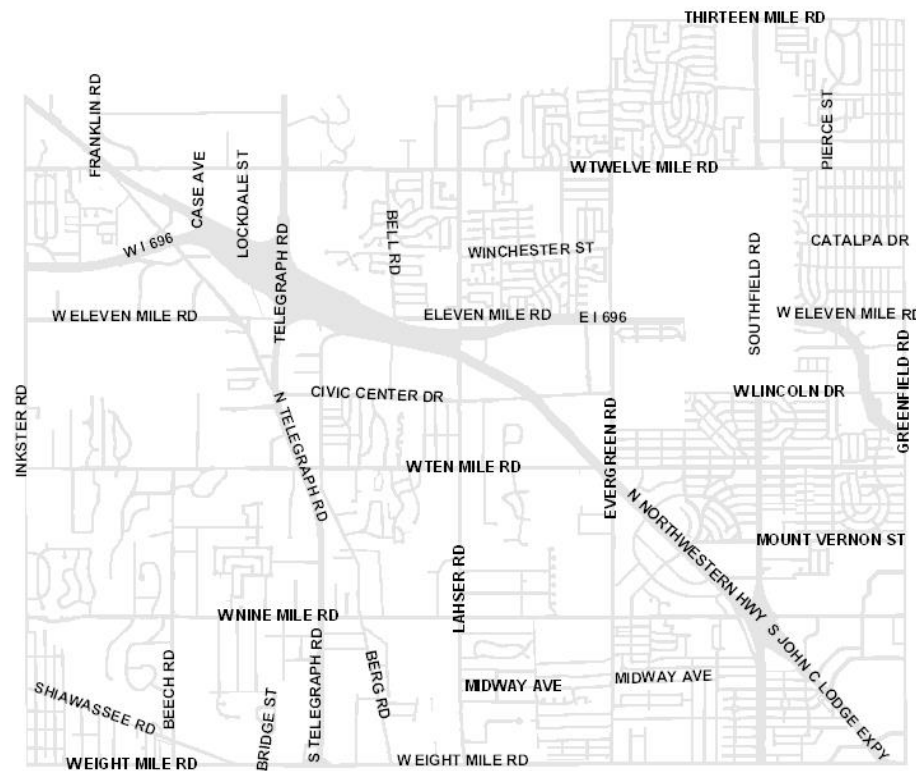

Suspect stole a Laptop and fled the scene. Surveillance video shows suspect was wearing some type of leather jacket, a gray hooded sweatshirt, and black shoes.

Officers arrived on scene and spoke to a female that claimed to be the fiancé of the lessee of the apartment. The brother of the lessee was also on scene and was on the phone with lessee.</p> <p>Lessee advises that he has no idea who the woman was in her apartment and he didn't give her permission to be in his apartment.</p> <p>Lessee later showed up on scene and confirmed he didn't know who the woman was.</p> <p>Further investigation revealed that the female may have some mental health issues. It appears she found the apartment door wall open and just made herself at home in the apartment and fabricated the whole story about lessee being her fiancé.</p> <p>At this time the female was arrested for Home Invasion.</p> <p>Victim states that if the female is truly suffering from any mental illness he didn't wish to prosecute.</p>
