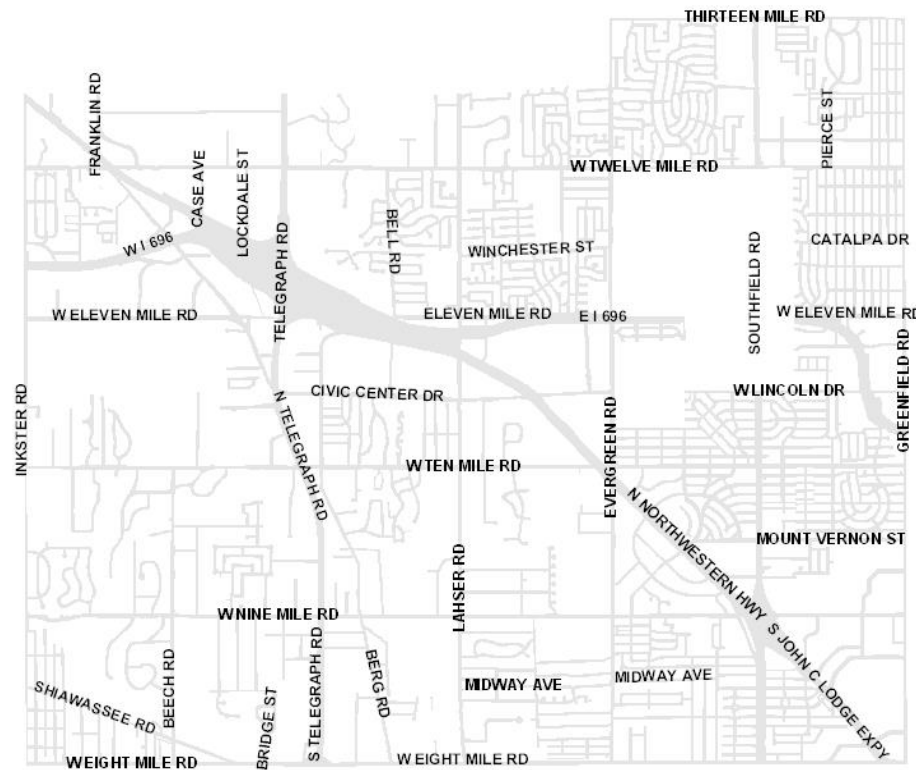

11/25/2017 9:59am	21000 Northwestern (Vacant-Shopping Center)	A door at the back of the old Target store was forced open. A padlock was broken off the door and a boot print was on the door.	<p>City worker discovered break-in and called the Property Manager and the Southfield Police.</p> <p>Appears that the incident occurred around 2:00am. The following was discovered:</p> <p>LARCENY: The demolition company who is currently demolishing part of the mall had a golf cart and misc. power tools stolen. Another environmental company had misc. hand tools and a microscope stolen.</p> <p>MDOP: A city pickup truck parked in a tunnel underneath the mall was vandalized. Graffiti was spray painted all over the vehicle.</p> <p>Throughout the tunnel, graffiti was spray painted on the wall. Someone spray painted the date 11/23/2017 2am (Most likely the time incident occurred) on the tunnel wall in the same color paint that was on the city truck.</p> <p>R/P also states that a golf cart might have been stolen. The golf cart did not have keys and it's believed the cart was hot-wired.</p>

(Barber Shop) Officers arrived on scene and discovered the front door was broken out. The owner showed up on scene and reviewed their surveillance video. Surveillance video shows suspect arrived in a red four door car, unknown make or model. B/M, 350 lbs. 6'-0" with a black beard. The owner advised that he is positive the suspect is an ex- co-worker. The owner, later provided additional information on the suspect. Incident is under investigation.</p>

(Commercial- Recycling)</p>	<p>Entry by drilling out deadbolt on garage door.</p>	<p>R/P from recycling business advises sometime between 4:00pm and the following morning at 6:45am someone forced entry into business through the garage door by drilling out the deadbolt. The only thing missing is a coin box that had an undisclosed amount of cash and possibly two paper checks.</p>

11/26/2017 2:15pm	27000 Greenfield Rd. (Apartments)	Apartment door was forced open.	The incident occurred sometime between 11/22/2017 3:00pm and 11/26/2017 2:00pm. When victim came home she noticed her door was damaged and standing open. Further investigation of the interior revealed that the apartment had been ransacked and several items were taken.

Victim received a call from employee stating that something happened and he would be late getting back with the truck.</p> <p>The employee never returned the work truck. Victim contacted employee's mother and discovered that the mother was following her son in the work truck in Farmington Hills. Suspects mother was crying because of the way her son was driving, running red lights etc., she believed that her son was back on crack cocaine. WBPD located suspect and attempted to stop the vehicle. The suspect fled from WBPD and the vehicle was last seen somewhere on 14 Mile Rd. Southfield Officers received information from dispatch that the suspect vehicle was N/B on Telegraph @ 12 Mile Rd. <p>Special Attention: LFA's Special Attention: Larceny from Vehicles How to prevent this from happening to you!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!) - If you have a garage you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage. - Wheel Locks are a deterrent but don't leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock. -After parking your vehicle turn your wheels all the way to the right or the left. alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately call 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the suspect(s) and suspect vehicles as you can. Stay on the phone with Dispatchers until the Police arrive.

-Lots of lighting around the area(s) that you park your vehicles is also very beneficial. Criminals don't like to work in well lighted areas. They prefer to work in darkness because it's difficult to see them.

CCW/ Possession of Marijuana & Obstruct- 2- Arrests

Officers stopped vehicle for traffic violations.

After approaching the vehicle, it was determined that the vehicle was occupied by two subjects and there was a strong odor of marijuana coming from the vehicle.

Investigation by Officers revealed that there were three small plastic baggies containing suspected marijuana and a handgun concealed under the front passenger seat.

The driver made admissions that the handgun was his and he stated he had a CPL.

The passenger made admissions that the suspected marijuana was his. Further investigation by Officers revealed that the driver didn't have a CPL and he was arrested for CCW.

The passenger didn't have a marijuana card and was arrested for Possession of Marijuana and Obstruction (False ID)

A Southfield Police Evidence Technician Field Tested the suspected Marijuana. The result was positive for possible presence of marijuana. Suspects were processed and lodged.

Officers located a suspicious occupied vehicle parked in the parking lot at Inglenook Park. (Park Curfew was in effect.)
