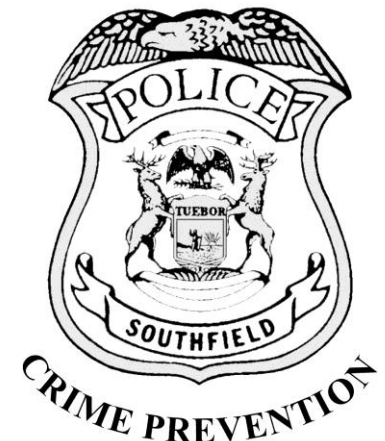
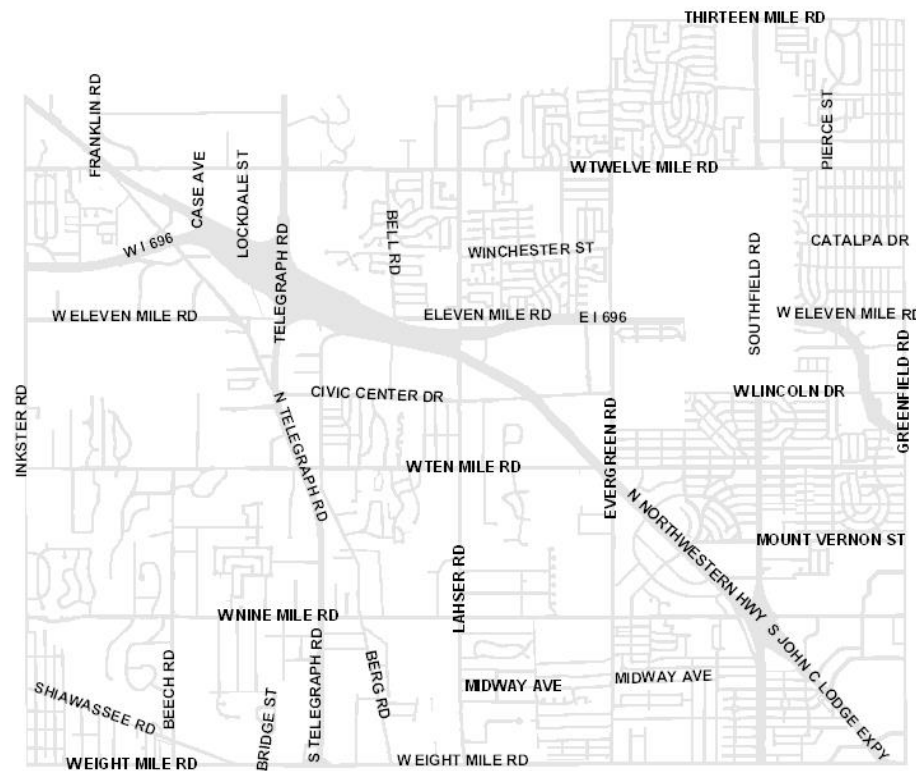

Officer stopped vehicle for numerous traffic violations.

After stopping vehicle Officer could smell a strong odor of marijuana coming from the vehicle and the person driving the vehicle driver's license was suspended out of California.

The driver made admissions that there were a couple marijuana cigarettes in the vehicle and gave consent to search the vehicle. Officers searched the vehicle and a Southfield Police K-9 also did a sweep of the vehicle. K-9 alerted to several areas of the vehicle. Officers recovered suspected Narcotics Paraphernalia, suspected Marijuana, suspected Methamphetamine Pills and Cash associated with the suspected narcotics.

A Southfield Police Evidence Technician Field Tested the suspected marijuana and the suspected methamphetamine. Both came back positive for possible presence of marijuana and methamphetamine respectively.

K-9 also did a currency sweep at the station with the money that was taken from suspect. The currency was forfeited and the suspect was served forfeiture notice.
