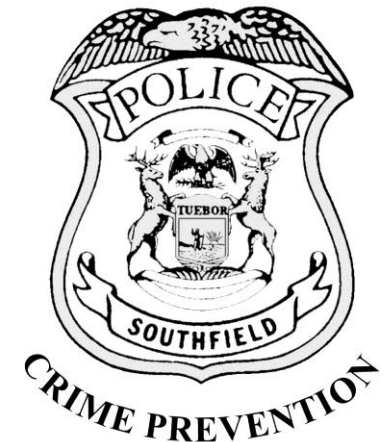

It appears that suspect(s) only entered the bedroom where window was broken out and took a TV. A Southfield Police Evidence Technician processed the scene and gathered evidence.
