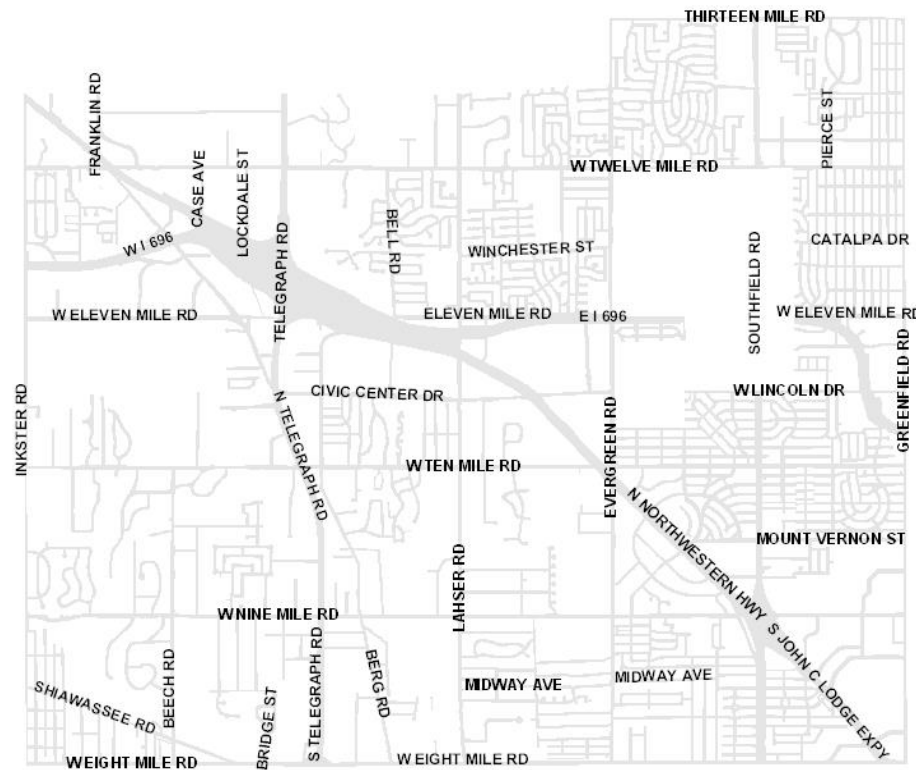

## Commercial Burglaries:

10/10/2016 1:48am	19000 W Ten Mile Rd. (Commercial- Party Store)	Front door glass was broken out.	<p>Officers were dispatched to alarm at Party Store. (Activation was at 1:48am)</p> <p>Officers arrived and discovered front door glass was broken out. Lottery tickets were observed on the floor inside the business and also in the east parking lot for business.</p> <p>A K-9 Unit was called to scene and tracked from business to the rear of another business where a Dark Blue T-Shirt with two holes poked through it and a bottle of Whiskey was recovered.</p> <p>It was later learned that the suspect wore the t-shirt over his head and the two holes were poked through the t-shirt for the eyes.</p> <p>Video Surveillance shows unknown male suspect approached the store on foot from the east at 1:47am. The suspect struck the glass with what seems to be a glass breaker. The suspect then pushed the glass through and climbed through the door. The suspect walked behind the counter grabbing multiple scratch off lottery tickets. The suspect was wearing the Dark Blue T-Shirt that was recovered over his head, dark colored gloves, a grey hooded sweatshirt, and long pants and was carrying a white backpack.</p> <p>The owner was on scene and states lottery tickets, a bottle of Whiskey, and some cigarettes were taken.</p>

Paper Documents were taken from victims 1997 Ford Escape.</p>	<p>Victim's states a folder with misc. papers including social security cards, birth certificates and title to his new vehicle were taken while he was in the business. Note: Prior to this incident victim states he did an even up swap of his vehicle for another vehicle. Victim states the two vehicles were exchanged and the titles were signed over between victim and a subject that is known to victim. The vehicle that victim had received is a Ford Escape. The vehicle that he swapped was a Buick. When victim got home after discovering the theft of all the misc. documents including the title of the vehicle he just got, an unknown B/F walked up to him and gave him the registration for the vehicle he had just swapped. Victim then received a threat from subject (person he just did the swap with) that he was going to report the car he just swapped stolen. It appears that the suspect in the Larceny isn't happy with the swap of vehicles? The suspect has been identified and incident is under investigation.</p>

Childs Clothing that was just purchased was also taken from the vehicle.</p>	<p>Victim states sometime between 7:00pm and the following morning at 10:30am someone broke out the driver's side rear window located the wheel lock key in the passenger seat pocket and then stole All Four Wheels and Tires from vehicle. Suspect(s) also took child's clothing that was just purchased by victim. In all, three vehicles were attacked within this Apartment Complex Two of the vehicles had Wheel Locks that were found inside the victims vehicle.</p>

(Commercial Retail)

Officer was assigned to the Loss Prevention Detail.

Officer was notified by the store manager that there was a B/M suspect exiting the store with several pairs of concealed eyeglasses.

The suspect had made no attempt to pay for the concealed eyeglasses.

Officer arrived to the entrance door where the suspect was exiting and yelled out to the suspect "POLICE STOP!" The suspect fled on foot west through the parking lot and then south across W. Eight Mile Rd.

Officer pursued suspect across 8 Mile Rd to the rear of business where the suspect scaled over a wall with serpentine wire.

Additional Officers continued the pursuit down an alleyway on the other side of the wall, located suspect and took suspect into custody without incident. Officers recovered suspected heroin and suspected prescription pills from suspect's pocket.

Upon the arrest of the suspect several pairs of designer eyeglasses and eyeglass cases that were taken from business were recovered from suspect's vest he was wearing.

## Special Attention: Larceny from Vehicles

### How to prevent this from happening to you!

-Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!)

- If you have a garage you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage.

- Wheel Locks are a deterrent but don't leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock.

- If you don't have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible.

-If you here any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately call 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the suspect(s) and suspect vehicles as you can. Stay on the phone with Dispatchers until the Police arrive.

## DWLS/ Possession of Marijuana/ Possession of Prescription

Officer stopped vehicle for traffic violation and the driver was texting at his phone while the vehicle was in motion.

As the vehicle was pulling over Officer observed the driver attempting to hide something between the front seats.

After making the stop it was discovered that the driver had a suspended license. After getting consent to search the vehicle Officers recovered suspected marijuana and a prescription bottle with suspected un-prescribed pills.

A Southfield Evidence technician Field Tested the suspected marijuana.

The result was positive for possible presence of marijuana.

-Lots of lighting around the area(s) that you park your vehicles is also very beneficial. Criminals don't like to work in well lighted areas. They prefer to work in darkness because it's difficult to see them.

Southfield Officer pulled up to one of the shelters and observed subject bend over and discard something between his legs. After exiting his vehicle a strong odor of marijuana was emanating from the shelter and there was a small clear zip lock bag on the ground directly behind the subject that bent over. The bag contained numerous unused, small, clear zip lock baggies (consistent with narcotics packaging)

The subject made admissions to smoking marijuana earlier in the shelter. The subject was searched and a baggie containing suspected marijuana was recovered.

The subject stated he didn't have any identification and gave Officers a false name. Officers utilized a portable finger print reader and discovered the subject's true identity.

A Southfield Evidence Technician Field Tested a sample of the suspected Marijuana. The result was positive for possible presence of marijuana.

The subject was arrested for Possession of Marijuana and Obstruct Police.

Embezzlement/ Possession of Crack Cocaine & Prescription  
Drugs- 1- Arrest

(Commercial Office)

Officers were dispatched to business on an Embezzlement Complaint. Investigation revealed that an employee that was in a position where her duties included writing checks on a daily basis to clients/vendors. R/P became concerned when one of their accounts wasn't balancing out. R/P investigated further and saw that the employee had written numerous checks to herself. The employee then forged R/P's signature and cashed the checks.

Officers spoke to employee. She denied any knowledge of the involvement in the writing or cashing of the checks. Employee was advised and placed under arrest for Embezzlement.

During the search incident to the arrest Officers recovered suspected Crack Cocaine, Un-Prescribed Prescription Pills and several "Pay Stubs" from the checks that employee fraudulently wrote to herself and cashed in suspects purse.

A Southfield Evidence Technician Field Tested the suspected Cocaine. The result was positive for possible presence of Cocaine.

OWI/ CPL Violation- 1- Arrest

Officers responded to call from citizen that a vehicle was stopped in the intersection and wasn't moving through several light cycles. Officer's located vehicle and observed driver passed out behind the wheel. The vehicle was running, in drive, and the driver had his foot on the brake. Dispatch also advised that the owner of the vehicle had a CPL Permit.

Once the driver was awakened he advised Officers that his handgun was in the glove box. Officers located and secured the handgun. Officers conducted an OWI Investigation and the driver was arrested for OWI. Suspect's handgun was confiscated and placed into SPD Evidence Locker. The driver was also charged with a CPL Violation.
