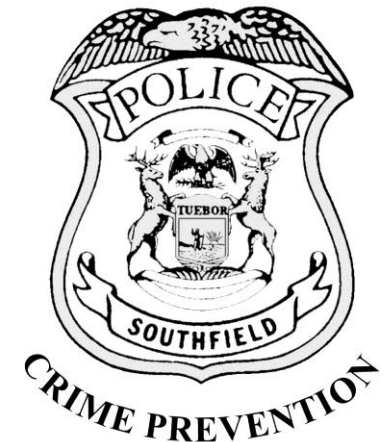

From: 10/15/2015 6:30pm To: 10/16/2015 8:30am	21000 Telegraph Rd. (Commercial Landscaping)	Pad Lock was cut off the door.	R/P (manager) states he was the last one to leave the business on 10/15/2015. R/P stated he secured the pad lock on the west entry door at the end of the business day. R/P returned to business the following day @ 8:00am and discovered unknown suspect(s) entered onto the property and forced entry into the garage/pole barn by cutting the pad lock hasp on the west entry door. The suspect(s) entered the garage where the tools are kept and took several hand/power tools. This is the second B&E at this location. The first incident occurred on 10/12/2015. Tools were also taken in this B&E. Same M.O.

(Commercial- Convenience Store)	Cash register was taken.	<p>Officers responded to Armed Robbery just occurred.</p> <p>Victim stated at approximately 4:00am suspect came into the store and then circled around the store for approximately 5-10 minutes.</p> <p>The suspect then left the store, reentered the store and was acting suspicious.</p> <p>The suspect purchased some items and then walked behind the counter and told employee to give him all the money.</p> <p>The suspect had something in his hand that employee felt was possibly a gun.</p> <p>The suspect then grabbed the register and jumped over the front counter and left the store.</p> <p>Surveillance video shows vehicle to be a Silver Pontiac or Chrysler vehicle. The front hood of the car had damage and appeared to be tied down.</p> <p>Suspect Description: W/M, 45-55 years old, short blond hair, medium build, and between 5'-8"-5'-10". He was wearing a long sleeve shirt and pants (all black).</p> <p>Southfield Police Detectives working the case developed a suspect. The suspect was later positively identified by the store employee as the person that was responsible for the Robbery.</p> <p>It was also discovered that the same suspect was responsible for similar Robbery in a neighboring jurisdiction.</p>

			<p>The Oakland County Prosecutors Office issued a warrant for suspect and the case is pending adjudication.</p>

(Commercial-Pharmacy)</p>	<p>Attempted to take Cash from the Cash Register.</p>	<p>Victim (cashier) stated at approx. 9:50am a younger white female (18-20 y.o.a.) approached her register with a 16-oz bottle of sprite for purchase. The female was wearing a black hooded jacket or high collar that was turned all the way up with a red/black scarf covering the rest of her head and face.</p> <p>The suspect produced a note indicating Robbery. Victim thought it was a joke and told the female she would have to call the manager. The female told her "not to use the phone or he's going to shoot." Officers responded to the 27000 Block of Greenfield Rd. (Health Department) on a report of an assault of a Deputy Sheriff. Information obtained is that a patient of the facility became hostile and aggressive when he was advised that he would not be seen today.
