



The suspect then left the store, reentered the store and was acting suspicious. The suspect purchased some items and then walked behind the counter and told employee to give him all the money. The suspect had something in his hand that employee felt was possibly a gun. The suspect then grabbed the register and jumped over the front counter and left the store. Surveillance video shows vehicle to be a Silver Pontiac or Chrysler vehicle. The front hood of the car had damage and appeared to be tied down. Suspect Description: W/M, 45-55 years old, short blond hair, medium build, and between 5'-8-5'-10. He was wearing a long sleeve shirt and pants (all black). Southfield Police Detectives working the case developed a suspect. The suspect was later positively identified by the store employee as the person that was responsible for the Robbery. It was also discovered that the same suspect was responsible for similar Robbery in a neighboring jurisdiction.

	The Oakland County Prosecutors Office issued a warrant for suspect and the case is pending adjudication.
