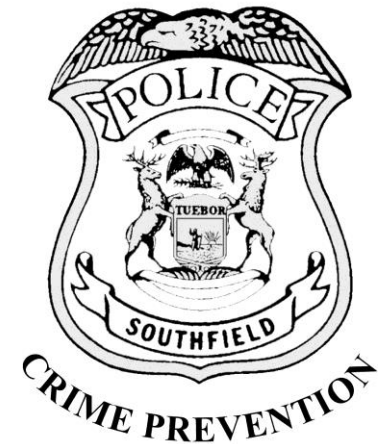
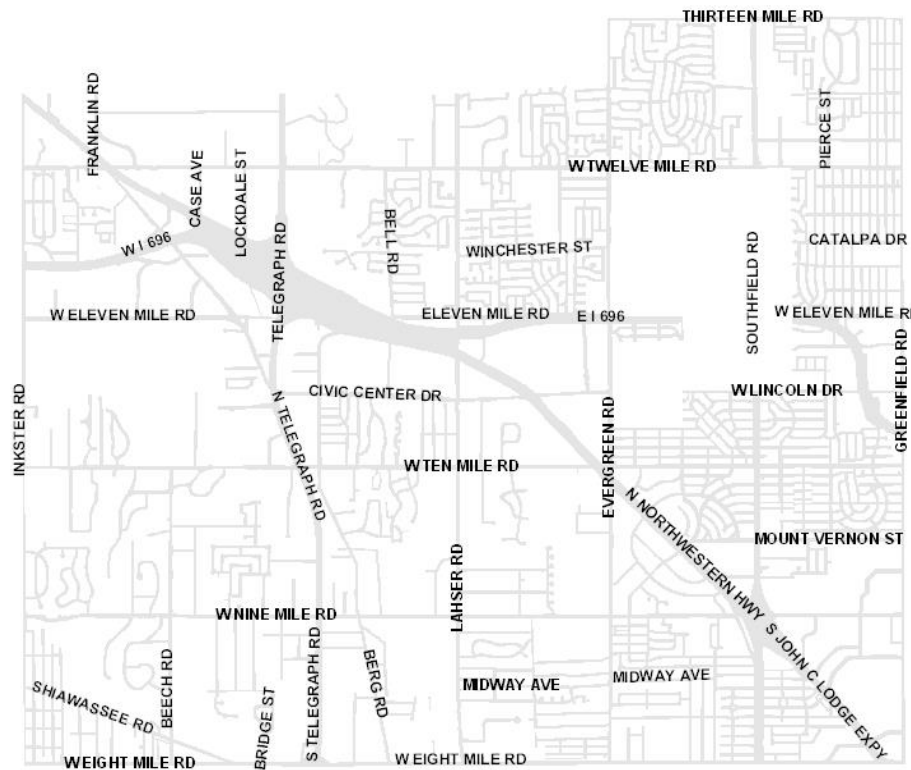

Date/Time	Address (block range)	Method of Entry	Description/Suspect Information
10/15/2018 2:02am	26000 W Twelve Mile (Commercial- Restaurant)	Window was broken out on business.	<p>Officers were on patrol in the area of Twelve Mile and Northwestern. (2:00am) They observed two suspicious males walking in the parking lot of the shopping plaza that was closed for business. They approached the two subjects and observed a sledge hammer on the ground within a few feet of the subjects. Both males had dark hooded sweatshirts on and possessed gloves. One had a crow bar hidden in his pant leg.</p> <p>Neither had any explanation as to why they were in the area and both were sweating profusely.</p> <p>Additional Officers found a broken window at a restaurant in the plaza. Entry was gained into the restaurant and the safe was damaged in an attempt to gain entry into it. Video surveillance footage showed images of the two suspects inside the restaurant striking the safe with a small sledge hammer. The store manager advised that cash was missing from the cash drawers. The cash drawer was recovered outside behind the restaurant. One of the suspects was a past employee. Both were arrested for Breaking & Entering. Great Job by all Officers that were involved in this Investigation & Arrest.</p>

She was sitting in her vehicle and observed an unknown White SUV type vehicle parked in front of the apartment complex with an unknown male in the driver's seat. Officers recovered a large machete type knife from a dresser in a bedroom. Suspect wasn't located at this time.

It appeared that he was going to flee from Officers but Officers positioned their vehicles to prevent his escape. The driver refused to exit the vehicle and had to be persuaded to exit.

The driver then became aggressive towards Officers and Officers had to use the necessary force to affect the arrest.

Special Attention: Larceny from Vehicles

How to prevent this from happening to you!

-Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!)

- If you have a garage you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage.

- Wheel Locks are a deterrent but don't leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock.

-After parking your vehicle turn your wheels all the way to the right or the left. This will make it difficult to get the lug nuts off the front wheels.

-If you don't have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible

-If you here any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately call 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the suspect(s) and suspect vehicles as you can. Stay on the phone with Dispatchers until the Police

Recently several citizens have had packages that were delivered to their residences and apartments stolen prior to them retrieving the packages.

Citizens can prevent this from happening by scheduling a specific time to have the package delivered and be waiting for the package.

Citizen can also schedule the package to be picked up by themselves at the common carrier facility.

Officers went to location in Sterling Heights, Mi. to look for suspect wanted for fleeing and eluding. The suspect fled from Officers on 10//17/2018.

Officers were conducting surveillance and observed the suspect vehicle occupied by two subjects. Officers immediately pulled behind the vehicle and activated their emergency lights.
