



(2:00am) They observed two suspicious males walking in the parking lot of the shopping plaza that was closed for business. They approached the two subjects and observed a sledge hammer on the ground within a few feet of the subjects. Both males had dark hooded sweatshirts on and possessed gloves. One had a crow bar hidden in his pant leg. Neither had any explanation as to why they were in the area and both were sweating profusely. Additional Officers found a broken window at a restaurant in the plaza. Entry was gained into the restaurant and the safe was damaged in an attempt to gain entry into it. Video surveillance footage showed images of the two suspects inside the restaurant striking the safe with a small sledge hammer. The store manager advised that cash was missing from the cash drawers. The cash drawer was recovered outside behind the restaurant. One of the suspects was a past employee. Both were arrested for Breaking & Entering. Great Job by all Officers that were involved in this Investigation & Arrest.


