Southfield TCSU Officers were conducting an area search for suspects that were involved in two separate Robberies that occurred in the city of Farmington Hills.

Southfield TCSU Officer observed a White Chevy Malibu S/B Telegraph at 12 Mile Rd.

The vehicle and occupants fit the description of those wanted in connection of the two-Armed Robberies in Farmington Hills.

TCSU Officers attempted to stop the vehicle on S/B Telegraph at 9 Mile. The vehicle stopped briefly then fled from officers. The vehicle was pursued on 9 Mile into Farmington Hills where a P.I.T. maneuver was utilized ending the pursuit. Three suspects were taken into custody without further incident.

A gun, ski mask, and other evidence related to the robberies was recovered.

All suspects and evidence were turned over to Farmington Hills Police except for complaint and warrant being sought for the Southfield charge for Fleeing & Eluding.

It was later discovered that these suspects were responsible for numerous Robberies extending from Lansing to the Metro Detroit area.
