


Officers were dispatched to location on the report of a male with a knife and a female that locked herself in the bathroom.

1- Arrest

While en-route dispatch radioed the male was pounding on the bathroom door with a hammer and dispatch could hear the female yelling.

When Officers got to the sixth floor dispatch radioed the male had a hammer and was still trying to get inside the bathroom. There were a couple of neighbors in the hallway and they were pointing to the end of the hallway saying someone needs help in the last apartment.
