



(Apartment Complex) 2- B/M's were observed breaking into vehicles. One B/M was described as wearing a black hoodie and the second black male was wearing black clothing. A Southfield Officer that was assigned to Task Force dealing with LFA's in the city was parked inside the complex and observed suspects going through vehicles and going from vehicle to vehicle pulling on door handles. Another Southfield Officer entered the Apartment Complex and initiated a stop of the two suspects. Both fled on foot refusing to stop. Special Attention: LFA's This Past Week Worth Noting: 1) 21000 Block of Telegraph Rd. (Car Dealership Storage Lot) Officers responded to a call from Security that there was a suspect with a flashlight walking inside the fenced in parking lot. Officers located one vehicle missing its Wheels & Tires. The suspect fled on foot when Officers arrived and wasn't located. The suspect's vehicle was parked along the north side fence. It was reported stolen. One set of Wheels & Tires that were taken from vehicle inside the parking lot were recovered with the suspect vehicle. It looks as though the suspect was prepared to take several more Wheels & Tires as there were several landscaping blocks, lug nuts, a screw driver and a 4-way lug wrench recovered near the vehicle. Special Attention: Larceny from Vehicles How to prevent this from happening to you!

-Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!)

- If you have a garage you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage.

- Wheel Locks are a deterrent but don't leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock.

- If you don't have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible.

-If you here any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately call 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the suspect(s) and suspect vehicles as you can. Stay on the phone with Dispatchers until the Police arrive. Fleeing & Eluding-1- Arrest09/15/201612:31amMount Vernon St. & Southfield Rd.

Southfield Officer observed subject on motorcycle commit several Traffic Violations. When the subject turned E/B on Mt. Vernon from Southfield Rd. Officer attempted to stop motorcycle.

The driver fled E/B on Mt. Vernon at a high rate of speed, and then turned S/B on Greenfield Rd. Officer lost sight of the motorcycle and terminated the chase at this point.

A short time later it was reported that an accident involving a motorcycle occurred at 8 Mile & Greenfield Rd.

Officers responded to accident and determined that the motorcycle involved was the same motorcycle that fled from Officer earlier. The driver of the motorcycle was located hiding in the bushes on the north side of 8 Mile, west of Greenfield Rd.
