Security observed a male wearing a white hooded sweatshirt walking around the southeast section of the parking lot. Officers arrived on scene and observed a section of fencing on the west side of the parking lot that had been cut. Officers observed the suspect walking inside the fenced in area. When the suspect observed Officers he started running east towards the back of the parking lot, climbed up on a car, jumped over the fence with barbed wire, and could be heard running through the woods. Officers set up a perimeter in attempt to locate suspect. The suspect wasn't located. Officers located the suspect's vehicle parked and running along the north side of the fence to parking lot. Special Attention: LFA's This Past Week Worth Noting:

1) 21000 Block of Telegraph Rd.
(Car Dealership Storage Lot)

Officers responded to a call from Security that there was a suspect with a flashlight walking inside the fenced in parking lot. Officers located one vehicle missing its Wheels & Tires. The suspect fled on foot when Officers arrived and wasn't located.

The suspect's vehicle was parked along the north side fence. It was reported stolen. custody as well for interfering with Officers.

Special Attention: Larceny from Vehicles
How to prevent this from happening to you!

-Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!)

- If you have a garage you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage.

- Wheel Locks are a deterrent but don't leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock.

- If you don't have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible.

-If you here any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately call 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the suspect(s) and suspect vehicles as you can. Stay on the phone with Dispatchers until the Police arrive.

Fleeing & Eluding- 1- Arrest

Southfield Officer observed subject on motorcycle commit several Traffic Violations. When the subject turned E/B on Mt. Vernon from Southfield Rd. Officer attempted to stop motorcycle. After escorting the subject outside he refused the ride home and stated he would walk home. (Subject lives close by)

Subject however stayed on the property in the parking lot refusing to leave and started arguing and yelling obscenities at Officers.

The subject was taken into custody for Disorderly Person and Trespassing. When Officers attempted to handcuff the subject he pulled away from Officers and began resisting.

The subject had to be physically restrained and was eventually secured and transported to jail. The subject was highly intoxicated!
