(Area of numerous recent LFA's) Next to the van was a Red Ford Taurus occupied by 2 B/M's. The Red Ford Taurus upon seeing Officer immediately exited on to Beck Rd. then onto S/B on M-10. Officer observed miscellaneous items on the outside of the van including a gas can and clear liquid leaking from the vehicle which was later determined to be leaking from a cleaning reservoir container located inside the van. Officer was on routine patrol at 5:39am when he observed a U-Haul Truck occupied by three subjects backed into parking space on north side of Apartments Complex in the 16000 Block of North Park Dr.

Because of the numerous LFA's in the area, and the time of day, 5:39am, Officers investigated the subjects.

The subjects stated they were there to meet some girls and gave Officers conflicting stories as to why they were there. The subjects didn't know anyone who lived at the Apartment Complex and they didn't live there. Further investigation by Officers they were given consent to search the vehicle.

During the search of the vehicle Officers recovered a handgun and one of the subjects gave Officers false information regarding his identity.

The handgun was confiscated and one subject was arrested for Obstruction. (Giving Officers false ID)

The handgun will be sent to the Lab for further analysis.

How to prevent this from happening to you!

-Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!)

- If you have a garage you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage.

- Wheel Locks are a deterrent but don't leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock.

-After parking your vehicle turn your wheels all the way to the right or the left. This will make it difficult to get the lug nuts off the front wheels.

-If you don't have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible.

-If you here any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately call 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers

R&O/ Weapons Offense/ Disorderly Conduct- 1- Arrest

20000 Block of Oldham Rd.

Officers were dispatched to the 20000 Block of Oldham Rd.

(Apartment Complex) on a suspicious person(s) one may have a gun in their Apartment Building.

Officers arrived and located five (5) subjects, 2- males and 3- females inside the apartment building.

During Officers investigation and because there was mention of one of the subjects having a gun Officers attempted to pat down subjects.

One of the males refused to cooperate and resisted officers pat down.

The situation got worse when Officers felt what appeared to be a handgun in the subject's waist band. This subject was eventually restrained & handcuffed and a BB Gun was recovered in the subject's waistband. Officers also located numerous Credit Cards in the subject's pocket.

While restraining this subject he continued to yell and cause a scene in the common area of the apartment building. The subject yelled several racially motivating comments towards the Officers.

This subject was arrested for Disorderly, Resisting, Obstructing Police, and Possession of a Spring- Loaded Firearm. This subject was processed and placed in a juvenile holding cell. He was later released to his mother.
