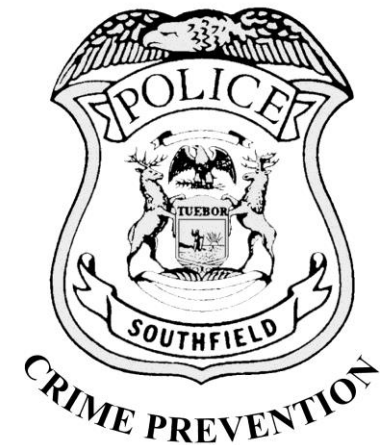
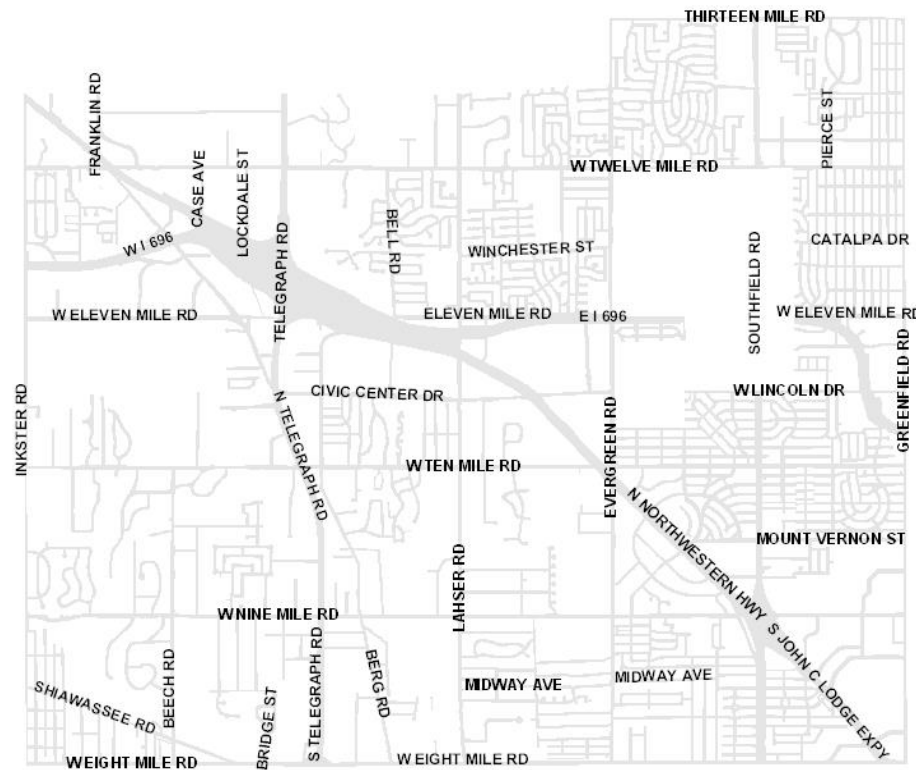

Stolen were several Misc. Stage Items.</p> <p>Surveillance video from the business next door captured the suspect vehicle entering their lot at 3:55am in the morning.</p> <p>The suspect car was a small black car; Possibly a Kia or Honda. The fence was cut between the 2 buildings. The suspects were on scene for about 35 minutes before leaving.</p> <p>No further information on the suspects.</p>

Maintenance worker is suspected.</p>	<p>Victim received a notification on his phone from his camera system showing someone breaking into his business. Victim met with Officers at his business. No forced entry was noted but several lottery tickets are missing from the business. Victim brought up video of incident. The suspect was a B/M wearing a grey sweatshirt with yellow writing on it, dark blue jeans, red and white baseball cap and white gloves. Investigation revealed that the suspect was one of the maintenance workers for the complex. Incident is under investigation.</p>

R/P stated that he was still in a dreamlike state and thought his cousin was in the room and asked if it was her.</p> <p>The subject replied yes and then left through the small sliding basement window. R/P realized the person was not his cousin and went and got his father from upstairs.</p> <p>The father looked out the door and saw a black vehicle (unknown make/model) leaving at a high rate of speed.</p> <p>R/P could not provide any further description except that the subject was black and had a hoodie on (Unknown color). R/P was still uncertain if the suspect was male or female. R/P stated that the suspect had some type of rectangular object in their hand.</p>
