


Rep. from Construction Company (R/P) states that the construction trailer was locked with construction tools inside with a pad lock at the end of business on 09/08/2015 @7:00pm. Several tools were discovered missing at approx. 4:00pm on the following day when the pad lock was discovered cut and partially missing. There are no suspects or witnesses at this time. The tools would require a minimum of two persons to remove due to their weight. The construction trailer is a semi- trailer with wooden stairs for access.

Victim stated the female is known to her, however, she could not initially provide her name.</p> <p>Victim stated that she didn't confront suspect because she didn't want to start a confrontation.</p> <p>When questioned about why this person would break into her motel room, victim became frustrated and made inconsistent statements and she could not provide any further details?</p>

09/09/2015 8:16pm	26000 W Nine Mile Rd	Attempt on Barn Door.	<p>Victim first observed suspect walking away from her barn at approx. 1:15pm. (Didn't call police)</p> <p>At approximately 8:15pm victim heard some noise outside and thought it was her boyfriend. She went outside and saw a white male wearing a red shirt, baggy pants and black Nike shoes.</p> <p>There was another white male wearing all dark clothing. Both males saw the R/P and fled west down the hill through the yard. The R/P recognized the white male in the red shirt from earlier in the day.</p> <p>A Southfield Police K-9 conducted a track and tracked south west (approximately 30 yards) to the rear door in the 22000 Block of Rougemont.</p> <p>Officer's made contact with the resident at this location and it checked ok.</p> <p>K-9 casted again and tracked out to 9 mile, across 9 mile and the track was terminated.</p> <p>A possible suspect vehicle was seen earlier in the day.
