



VOTE NOVEMBER 3rd
PROPOSED CHARTER AMENDMENT

Shall Chapters III and XI of the City Charter be amended to reinstate Primary Elections as provided for prior to 2015.

What is a Primary Election?

A primary election determines which candidates will be on the ballot in November general Election. The candidate who gets the most votes will be on the November general election ballot.





What did the Southfield City Charter state Prior to 2015?

WHEN ONLY ONE (1) PERSON IS TO BE ELECTED TO ANY ONE (1) OFFICE, THEN THE TWO (2) CANDIDATE RECEIVING THE HIGHEST NUMBER OF VOTES FOR NOMINATION TO THAT OFFICE SHALL BE THE CANDIDATES AND THE ONLY CANDIDATES, WHOSE NAMES SHALL BE PLACED UPON THE BALLOT FOR THAT OFFICE AT THE REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION. WHEN MORE THAN ONE (1) PERSON IS TO BE ELECTED TO ANY OFFICE, THEN THE CANDIDATES, EQUAL IN NUMBER TO TWICE THE NUMBER OF PERSONS TO BE ELECTED TO THAT OFFICE, RECEIVING THE HIGHEST NUMBER OF VOTES FOR SAID OFFICE, AND NO OTHERS, SHALL BE PLACED UPON THE BALLOT AS CANDIDATES FOR SAID OFFICE AT THE NEXT REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION.
