The Comprehensive Master Plan of the City of Southfield was adopted in April 2009. At least every 5 years after adoption of a master plan, the Planning Commission shall review the Master Plan and determine whether to amend the Master Plan or adopt a new Master Plan. Thus, the Planning Department and Planning Commission will begin to hold a series of public workshops to receive input from the resident and business community.
