
Sewer, Septic System & Well Forum October 25 | 6:30 p.m.

The City of Southfield will hold a public forum on septic systems and wells to inform residents who are not connected to city water and sewer systems on the care and maintenance of both. The forum is set for Wednesday, October 25 at 6:30 p.m. at Levey Middle School (25300 W. Nine Mile Road).

The forum will feature a presentation by Oakland County Health Department Chief Sanitarian Christopher Strnad on the care and management of septic systems and wells used for drinking and other domestic purposes.
